## Pt. 1

### Hebrews 11:6 NKJV

<sup>6</sup> But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

### 2 Peter 1:3-4 NKJV

<sup>3</sup> as His divine power has given to us all things that *pertain* to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, **4** by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption *that is* in the world through lust.

### Isaiah 43:1-2 NKJV

But now, thus says the Lord, who created you, O Jacob,  
And He who formed you, O Israel:  
“Fear not, for I have redeemed you;  
I have called *you* by your name;  
You *are* Mine.

<sup>2</sup> When you pass through the waters, I *will be* with you;  
And through the rivers, they shall not overflow you.

<sup>19</sup> And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

### 2 Corinthians 1:20 NKJV

<sup>20</sup> For all the promises of God in Him *are* Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.

### **1 Peter 5:8-9 NKJV**

<sup>8</sup> Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. <sup>9</sup> Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world.

### **Number 13:28-33 NKJV**

Nevertheless the people who dwell in the land *are* strong; the cities *are* fortified *and* very large; moreover we saw the descendants of Anak there. <sup>29</sup> The Amalekites dwell in the land of the South; the Hittites, the Jebusites, and the Amorites dwell in the mountains; and the Canaanites dwell by the sea and along the banks of the Jordan.” <sup>30</sup> Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses, and said, “Let us go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to overcome it.” <sup>31</sup> But the men who had gone up with him said, “We are not able to go up against the people, for they *are* stronger than we.” <sup>32</sup> And they gave the children of Israel a bad report of the land which they had spied out, saying, “The land through which we have gone as spies *is* a land that devours its inhabitants, and all the people whom we saw in it *are* men of *great* stature.” <sup>33</sup> There we saw the giants (the descendants of Anak came from the giants); and we were like grasshoppers in our own sight, and so we were in their sight.”

### **Numbers 14:23 NKJV**

<sup>23</sup> they certainly shall not see the land of which I swore to their fathers, nor shall any of those who rejected Me see it.

### **Numbers 14:28-29 NKJV**

<sup>28</sup> Say to them, ‘As I live,’ says the Lord, ‘just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will do to you: <sup>29</sup> The carcasses of you who have complained against Me shall fall in this wilderness, all of you who were numbered, according to your entire number, from twenty years old and above.

### **Joshua 23:14 NKJV**

<sup>14</sup> “Behold, this day I *am* going the way of all the earth. And you know in all your hearts and in all your souls that not one thing has failed of all the good things which the Lord your God spoke concerning you. All have come to pass for you; not one word of them has failed.

### **Hebrews 10:35-36 NKJV**

<sup>35</sup> Therefore do not cast away your confidence, which has great reward. <sup>36</sup> For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise:

**Romans 3:25 NKJV**

**25** whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed,

**Galatians 3:13-14 NKJV**

<sup>13</sup> Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed *is* everyone who hangs on a tree"<sup>[a]</sup>), **14** that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

**Galatians 3:29 NKJV**

<sup>29</sup> And if you *are* Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

**Galatians 2:17 NKJV**

<sup>17</sup> "But if, while we seek to be justified by Christ, we ourselves also are found sinners, *is* Christ therefore a minister of sin? Certainly not!

**Galatians 3:29 NKJV**

<sup>29</sup> And if you *are* Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

**Numbers 6:23-27 NKJV**

<sup>23</sup> "Speak to Aaron and his sons, saying, 'This is the way you shall bless the children of Israel. Say to them: <sup>24</sup> "The Lord bless you and keep you; <sup>25</sup> The Lord make His face shine upon you, And be gracious to you; <sup>26</sup> The Lord lift up His countenance upon you, And give you peace.'" <sup>27</sup> "So they shall put My name on the children of Israel, and I will bless them."
