### **Galatians 3:13 NKJV**

<sup>13</sup> Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, “Cursed *is* everyone who hangs on a tree”),

### **Exodus 20:5 NKJV**

<sup>5</sup> you shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, the Lord your God, *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth *generations* of those who hate Me,

### **Isaiah 53:6 NKJV**

<sup>6</sup> All we like sheep have gone astray;  
We have turned, every one, to his own way;  
And the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

### **Proverbs 26:2 NKJV**

<sup>2</sup> Like a flitting sparrow, like a flying swallow,  
So a curse without cause shall not alight.

### **Ephesians 6:12 NKJV**

<sup>12</sup> For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual *hosts* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*.

### **Exodus 20:6 NKJV**

<sup>6</sup> but showing mercy to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.

### **2 Timothy 1:5 NKJV**

<sup>5</sup> when I call to remembrance the genuine faith that is in you, which dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am persuaded is in you also.

### **Deuteronomy 28:15-19 NKJV**

<sup>15</sup> “But it shall come to pass, if you do not obey the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all His commandments and His statutes which I command you today, that all these curses will come upon you and overtake you: <sup>16</sup> “Cursed *shall you be* in the city, and cursed *shall you be* in the country. <sup>17</sup> “Cursed *shall be* your basket and your kneading bowl. <sup>18</sup> “Cursed *shall be* the fruit of your body and the produce of your land, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flocks. <sup>19</sup> “Cursed *shall you be* when you come in, and cursed *shall you be* when you go out.

**Malachi 3:9 NKJV**

You are cursed with a curse,  
For you have robbed Me,  
*Even* this whole nation.

**Genesis 12:2-3 NKJV**

<sup>2</sup> I will make you a great nation; I will bless you And make your name great;  
And you shall be a blessing. <sup>3</sup> I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who  
curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

**Proverbs 28:13 NKJV**

<sup>13</sup> He who covers his sins will not prosper,  
But whoever confesses and forsakes *them* will have mercy.

**Nehemiah 1:6 NKJV**

<sup>6</sup> please let Your ear be attentive and Your eyes open, that You may hear the prayer of  
Your servant which I pray before You now, day and night, for the children of Israel Your  
servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel which we have sinned against  
You. Both my father's house and I have sinned.

**Matthew 1:17 NKJV**

<sup>17</sup> So all the generations from Abraham to David *are* fourteen generations, from David  
until the captivity in Babylon *are* fourteen generations, and from the captivity in Babylon  
until the Christ *are* fourteen generations.

**Lamentations 5:7 NKJV**

<sup>7</sup> Our fathers sinned *and are* no more,  
But we bear their iniquities.

**Galatians 3:13-14 NKJV**

<sup>13</sup> Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for  
it is written, “Cursed *is* everyone who hangs on a tree”), <sup>14</sup> that the blessing of Abraham  
might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the  
Spirit through faith.

**Habakkuk 2:4 NKJV**

<sup>4</sup> “Behold the proud, His soul is not upright in him; But the just shall live by his faith.

**1 Peter 1:18-19 NKJV**

<sup>18</sup> knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, *like* silver or gold, from  
your aimless conduct *received* by tradition from your fathers, <sup>19</sup> but with the precious  
blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

**Hebrews 12:22-24 NKJV**

<sup>22</sup> But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, to an innumerable company of angels, <sup>23</sup> to the general assembly and church of the firstborn *who are* registered in heaven, to God the Judge of all, to the spirits of just men made perfect, <sup>24</sup> to Jesus the Mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than *that of* Abel.

**Romans 3:25 NKJV**

<sup>25</sup> whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed,

**Romans 3:20 NIV**

<sup>20</sup> Therefore no one will be declared righteous in God's sight by the works of the law; rather, through the law we become conscious of our sin.
