

COVENANT KEEPING KINDNESS (STAND pt 6)

ROMANS 3:25 (ASV)

25 whom God set forth *to be* a propitiation, through faith, in his blood, to show his righteousness because of the passing over of the sins done aforetime, in the forbearance of God;

HEBREWS 10:19 (NKJV)

19 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus,

HEBREWS 10:22 (NKJV)

22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

GENESIS 15:5-6 (NKJV)

5 Then He brought him outside and said, "Look now toward heaven, and count the stars if you are able to number them." And He said to him, "So shall your descendants be." 6 And he believed in the Lord, and He accounted it to him for righteousness.

HEBREWS 11:6 (NKJV)

All nations on Earth will find themselves blessed through your descendants because you obeyed me.”

PSALMS 136:15 (NKJV)

15 But overthrew Pharaoh and his army in the Red Sea, For His mercy *endures* forever;

ISAIAH 43:4 (NKJV)

4 Since you were precious in My sight, You have been honored, And I have loved you; Therefore I will give men for you, And people for your life.

I SAMUEL 18:3-4 (NKJV)

3 Then Jonathan and David made a covenant, because he loved him as his own soul. 4 And Jonathan took off the robe that was on him and gave it to David, with his armor, even to his sword and his bow and his belt.

SAMUEL 9:1 (NKJV)

29 Now David said, “Is there still anyone who is left of the house of Saul, that I may show him kindness for Jonathan’s sake?”

2 SAMUEL 9:6 (NKJV)

6 Now when Mephibosheth the son of Jonathan, the son of Saul, had come to David, he fell on his face and prostrated himself. Then David said, “Mephibosheth?” And he answered, “Here is your servant!”

2 SAMUEL 9:7 (NKJV)

7 So David said to him, “Do not fear, for I will surely show you kindness for Jonathan your father’s sake, and will restore to you all the land of Saul your grandfather; and you shall eat bread at my table continually.”

HEBREWS 8:13 (NKJV)

13 In that He says, "A new *covenant*," He has made the first obsolete. Now what is becoming obsolete and growing old is ready to vanish away.
