

FIGHT THE GOOD FIGHT

2 TIMOTHY 4:7 (NIV)

7 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.

ECCLESIASTES 8:8

(NKJV) 8 No one has power over the spirit to retain the spirit, And no one has power in the day of death. *There is* no release from that war, And wickedness will not deliver those who are given to it.

(ASV) 8 There is no man that hath power over the spirit to retain the spirit; neither hath he power over the day of death; and there is no discharge in war: neither shall wickedness deliver him that is given to it.

JUDE 3 (NKJV)

3 Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints.

JOSHUA 1:5 (NKJV)

5 No man shall *be able to* stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you.

JOSHUA 1:6 (NKJV)

6 Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them.

JOSHUA 1:7 (NKJV)

7 Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go.

JOSHUA 1:9 (NKJV)

9 Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God *is* with you wherever you go.”

JOSHUA 1:18 (NKJV)

18 Whoever rebels against your command and does not heed your words, in all that you command him, shall be put to death. Only be strong and of good courage.”

I SAMUEL 30:4 (NKJV)

4 Then David and the people who *were* with him lifted up their voices and wept, until they had no more power to weep.

I SAMUEL 30:5 (NKJV)

5 And David’s two wives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the widow of Nabal the Carmelite, had been taken captive.

I SAMUEL 30:6 (NKJV)

6 Now David was greatly distressed, for the people spoke of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and his daughters. But David strengthened himself in the Lord his God.

PSALM 116:7 (NKJV)

7 Return to your rest, O my soul,
For the Lord has dealt bountifully with you.

PSALMS 116:8 (NKJV)

8 For You have delivered my soul from death,
My eyes from tears, *And* my feet from falling.

PHILIPPIANS 1:6 (NKJV)

6 being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete *it* until the day of Jesus Christ;

PSALMS 91:2 (NKJV)

2 I will say of the Lord, "*He is* my refuge and my fortress;
My God, in Him I will trust."

PSALM 27:1 (NKJV)

1 The Lord *is* my light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear?
The Lord *is* the strength of my life; Of whom shall I be afraid?

I SAMUEL 23:16 (NKJV)

16 Then Jonathan, Saul's son, arose and went to David in the woods and strengthened his hand in God.

PROVERBS 24:16 (NIV)

16 for though the righteous fall seven times, they rise again,
but the wicked stumble when calamity strikes.

DEUTERONOMY 20:4 (NIV)

4 For the Lord your God is the one who goes with you to fight for you against your enemies to give you victory.
