# THE BLESSINGS Fight For Your Family pt. 2

## NEHEMIAH 4:16b (NIV)

<sup>16</sup> From that day on, half of my men did the work, while the other half were equipped with spears, shields, bows and armor. The officers posted themselves behind all the people of Judah

#### NEHEMIAH 4:16-18 (NKJV)

<sup>16</sup> So it was, from that time on, *that* half of my servants worked at construction, while the other half held the spears, the shields, the bows, and *wore* armor; and the leaders *were* behind all the house of Judah. <sup>17</sup> Those who built on the wall, and those who carried burdens, loaded themselves so that with one hand they worked at construction, and with the other held a weapon. <sup>18</sup> Every one of the builders had his sword girded at his side as he built. And the one who sounded the trumpet *was* beside me.

## DEUTERONOMY 30:19 (NKJV)

<sup>19</sup> I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, *that* I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live;

# 2 TIMOTHY 4:7 (NKJV)

<sup>7</sup> I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.

# MARK 10:14-16 (NKJV)

<sup>14</sup> But when Jesus saw *it,* He was greatly displeased and said to them, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God. <sup>15</sup> Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it." <sup>16</sup> And He took them up in His arms, laid *His* hands on them, and blessed them.

#### MARK 10:11-13 (NKJV)

<sup>11</sup> So He said to them, "Whoever divorces his wife and marries another commits adultery against her. <sup>12</sup> And if a woman divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery." <sup>13</sup> Then they brought little children to Him, that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked those who brought *them*.

# PROVERBS 18:21a (NKJV)

<sup>21</sup> Death and life *are* in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.

#### GENESIS 48:13-18 (NKJV)

<sup>13</sup> And Joseph took them both, Ephraim with his right hand toward Israel's left hand, and Manasseh with his left hand toward Israel's right hand, and brought *them* near him. <sup>14</sup> Then Israel stretched out his right hand and laid *it* on Ephraim's head, who *was* the younger, and his left hand on Manasseh's head, guiding his hands knowingly, for Manasseh *was* the firstborn. <sup>15</sup> And he blessed Joseph, and said:"God, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac walked, The God who has fed me all my life long to this day, <sup>16</sup> The Angel who has redeemed me from all evil, Bless the lads; Let my name be named upon them, And the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; And let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth." <sup>17</sup> Now when Joseph saw that his father laid his right hand on the head of Ephraim, it displeased him; so he took hold of his father's hand to remove it from Ephraim's head to Manasseh's head. <sup>18</sup> And Joseph said to his father, "Not so, my father, for this *one is* the firstborn; put your right hand on his head."

#### NUMBERS 6:22-27 (NKJV)

<sup>22</sup> And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying: <sup>23</sup> "Speak to Aaron and his sons, saying, 'This is the way you shall bless the children of Israel. Say to them: <sup>24</sup> "The Lord bless you and keep you; <sup>25</sup> The Lord make His face shine upon you, And be gracious to you; <sup>26</sup> The Lord lift up His countenance upon you, And give you peace." <sup>27</sup> "So they shall put My name on the children of Israel, and I will bless them."

# 3 JOHN 1:11 (NIV)

<sup>11</sup> Dear friend, do not imitate what is evil but what is good. Anyone who does what is good is from God. Anyone who does what is evil has not seen God.

#### **REVELATION 3:15-16 (NKJV)**

<sup>15</sup> "I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot. <sup>16</sup> So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth.

# DEUTERONOMY 6:6-7 (NKJV)

# GENESIS 49:28 (NKJV)

# GENESIS 49:29-30 (NKJV)

<sup>29</sup> Then he charged them and said to them: "I am to be gathered to my people; bury me with my fathers in the cave that *is* in the field of Ephron the Hittite, <sup>30</sup> in the cave that *is* in the field of Machpelah, which *is* before Mamre in the land of Canaan, which Abraham bought with the field of Ephron the Hittite as a possession for a burial place.

# GENESIS 49:31-33 (NKJV)

<sup>31</sup> There they buried Abraham and Sarah his wife, there they buried Isaac and Rebekah his wife, and there I buried Leah. <sup>32</sup> The field and the cave that *is* there *were* purchased from the sons of Heth." <sup>33</sup> And when Jacob had finished commanding his sons, he drew his feet up into the bed and breathed his last, and was gathered to his people.

# JOB 19:26 (NKJV)

<sup>26</sup> And after my skin is destroyed, this *I know*, That in my flesh I shall see God,
