

## **The Cross and The Blood** **(The Scarlet Line pt. 3)**

### **Romans 3:25 KJV**

Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

### **1 Peter 1:18-19 NKJV**

knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, 19 but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

### **Acts 20:28 NKJV**

Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

### **Leviticus 17:11 NKJV**

For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul.'

### **1 Corinthians 5:7b ESV**

... For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed.

### **Hebrews 13:20 NKJV**

Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,

### **Acts 2:31 NKJV**

he, foreseeing this, spoke concerning the resurrection of the Christ, that His soul was not left in Hades, nor did His flesh see corruption.

### **Genesis 3:15b GNT**

...Her offspring will crush your head...

### **Revelation 1:18 NKJV**

I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of Hades and of Death.

**Hebrews 9:11-12 NKJV**

But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

**Hebrews 9:12 AMPC**

He went once for all into the [Holy of] Holies [of heaven], not by virtue of the blood of goats and calves [by which to make reconciliation between God and man], but His own blood, having found *and* secured a complete redemption (an everlasting release for us).

**1 Thessalonians 4:13 NKJV**

But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope.

**2 Corinthians 5:8 NKJV**

...to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord.

**2 Corinthians 12:2 NKJV**

I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago—whether in the body I do not know, or whether out of the body I do not know, God knows—such a one was caught up to the third heaven.

**1 Thessalonians 4:14-18 NKJV**

For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus. For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. 16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. 17 Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord. 18 Therefore comfort one another with these words.

**Revelation 20:5 NKJV**

But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection.

**1 Corinthians 2:8 NKJV**

which none of the rulers of this age knew; for had they known, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

**Luke 22:3 NIV**

Then Satan entered Judas, called Iscariot, one of the Twelve.

**Revelation 7:13-15 NKJV**

Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, "Who are these arrayed in white robes, and where did they come from?" And I said to him, "Sir, you know." So he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. Therefore they are before the throne of God, and serve Him day and night in His temple. And He who sits on the throne will dwell among them.

**Romans 3:20 ICB**

because no one can be made right with God by following the law...

**Romans 1:16 KJV**

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

**Romans 1:16 LOVETT**

It is the power which emanates from God and saves all who believe in it. It reveals God's way of making men as righteous as Himself.

**2 Corinthians 5:21 NKJV**

For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

**Romans 1:16 STEVENS**

The Gospel, I say, can save men, for in it a way is revealed in which sinful men may be accepted before God and may stand in His presence approved and forgiven.

**Revelation 1:5-6 NKJV**

and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

## **Hebrews 10 NKJV**

### **Luke 18:10-14 NKJV**

“Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, ‘God, I thank You that I am not like other men—extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this tax collector. I fast twice a week; I give tithes of all that I possess.’ And the tax collector, standing afar off, would not so much as raise his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, ‘God, be merciful to me a sinner!’ I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other; for everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.”
