

# Beyond Sunday

## A Sermon Application Guide

This guide is designed to offer a simple tool for those wanting to take the next step with Sunday's message. You can print this guide to study on your own, or use it in a group and experience transformation together.

Our hope is that the living, breathing words of truth that are revealed to you become a part of your everyday life. In the book of James, we read about a key to living life with God. We are told that if we ask for wisdom by faith then we shall receive it generously from our Father in Heaven. One of the best ways to receive this wisdom is by preparing to receive it. We invite you to pray this prayer prior to the message and starting the study guide:

*“God, thank You for Your truth and wisdom. Help me to see what I need to see, hear what I need to hear, and know what I need to know. Holy Spirit, help me to understand in a way that shows me the Father’s true nature and heart. May this time help me to know You more and become more like Jesus. Amen.”*

Finding encouragement in times of uncertainty.

### **KEY CONCEPTS/TRUTHS**

Caution is needed when making major decisions in times of distress.

When things are dark, the church needs to be the light.

The world is looking for the hope that we carry.

We see things by faith that others cannot see.

Peace isn't determined by outside circumstances.

We can live by faith *and* respond to the world around us by faith.

We are called to overcome evil with good.

## **REAL-LIFE APPLICATION**

What are 3 things that you can do this week in order to allow this word to sink even deeper?

1. Recognize that God can do anything and get you anywhere in 24 hours.

- Study Daniel and his encounter in the lion's den
- Study Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego in the furnace
- Study Joseph being promoted from the prison to the palace

2. Meditate on Romans 8:28 and 8:31

3. Regularly re-anchor your soul (mind, will, and emotions) to Him and His Spirit. Set reminders for yourself to pause and re-anchor.

## **THIS WEEK'S DECLARATIONS**

Life is released when your words are in agreement with God. Intentionally speaking life and biblical truth out loud is extremely powerful. In fact, you have that very life in the power of your tongue. These words below, when spoken out loud, will cause an acceleration of the reality of God's words in your life. We encourage you

to speak the following with an expectancy to renew your mind and see God's fullness.

Thank You, God, that my love grows more perfect everyday I pursue You.

I have an abundance of grace and fullness of righteousness.

I look out not only for my own interests but also for the interests of others. I choose to love God and others as I respond by faith.

I am strengthened with power according to His might.

I have great endurance and patience.

I have not been given a spirit of fear. I have power, love, and a sound mind.

## **GREATER THINGS**

Keep these things in mind: God cannot lie, His promises are absolute and Jesus will never leave you. Anchor your soul in these truths and you will see greater things.

Now it's time to write down anything that the Lord has spoken to you. Praise Him, thank Him, and ask the Holy Spirit to help you walk this out.

## **Scripture References from the message** ***Under the Circumstances***

### **1 Samuel 30:1-4 NKJV**

Now it happened, when David and his men came to Ziklag, on the third day, that the Amalekites had invaded the South and Ziklag, attacked Ziklag and burned it with fire, **2** and had taken captive the women and those who *were* there, from small to great; they did not kill anyone, but carried *them* away and went their way. **3** So David and his men came to the city, and there it was, burned with fire; and their wives, their sons, and their daughters had been taken captive. **4** Then David and the people who *were* with him lifted up their voices and wept, until they had no more power to weep.

### **1 Samuel 30:6 CEB**

David was in deep trouble because the troops were talking about stoning him. Each of the soldiers was deeply distressed about their sons and daughters. But David found strength in the Lord his God.

### **1 Thessalonians 4:13-17 NKJV**

But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus. For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep.
