A Sermon Application Guide

**Unbelief (The Law of Faith pt 2)** 

This guide is designed to offer a simple tool for those wanting to take the next step with Sunday's message. You can print this guide to study on your own, or use it in a group and experience transformation together.

Our hope is that the living, breathing words of truth that are revealed to you become a part of your everyday life. In the book of James, we read about a key to living life with God. We are told that if we ask for wisdom by faith then we shall receive it generously from our Father in Heaven. One of the best ways to receive this wisdom is by preparing to receive it. We invite you to pray this prayer prior to the message and starting the study guide:

"God, thank You for Your truth and wisdom. Help me to see what I need to see, hear what I need to hear, and know what I need to know. Holy Spirit, help me to understand in a way that shows me the Father's true nature and heart. May this time help me to know You more and become more like Jesus. Amen."

# **Message Theme**

Uprooting Unbelief.

# **Key Concepts/Truths**

Unbelief can form many different ways:

- Wrong teaching
- Lack of knowledge
- Believing only what can be seen
- Refusing to believe
- Forgetting God's promises

Biblical theology needs to guide us instead of experiential theology.

God confirms His word and does what He says.

God's will is His word.

The testimony of Jesus strengthens our belief in who He is.

Which one truth do you already have evidence of in your life today? Ask the Lord for new ways to see even more of it for you and others around you. Write your answers out.

Which one truth is the most challenging or least existing in your life today? Why do you think this is? Ask the Lord if there are any beliefs or barriers that are keeping you from believing that particular truth. Write it out.

# **Real-Life Application**

5 practical ways to prevent unbelief in our lives:

### Value Relationship

Seek Him in all you do. Value relationship with Him above all things.

### Study the Word

My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. (Hosea 4:6) Study and dig deep into the Word of God and He will reveal Himself to you.

### Know the Holy Spirit

He is our Helper and leads us into all truth as we bring the eternal Kingdom of God to earth.

### Choose Faith

Choose to stand on your faith in God instead of the overwhelming circumstances around you.

# **Share Testimonies**

They triumphed over him [the devil] by the blood of the Lamb and the word of their testimony. Revelation 12:11. Remember the goodness of God! Share His faithfulness and grow in faith.

### This Week's Declarations

Life is released when your words are in agreement with God. Intentionally speaking life and biblical truth out loud is extremely powerful. In fact, you have that very life in the power of your tongue. These words below, when spoken out loud, will cause an acceleration of the reality of God's words in your life. We encourage you to speak the following with an expectancy to renew your mind and see God's fullness.

I chose to partner with God and not the enemy.

I have a role to play to see God's will done.

I am made by God to do good works and I will do them.

God has empowered me with every spiritual blessing.

I am the light of the world and I will shine before others, so that they may see my good works and give glory to God. I live to see God's will done on earth as it is in heaven.

# **Greater Things**

The testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy. What has God already done in your life? He is the same yesterday, today, and forever. What He did in your life yesterday, He can do today. Standing on that truth will destroy unbelief and open the door to His greater things.

### What's Next?

Now it's time to write down anything that the Lord has spoken to you. Praise Him, thank Him, and ask the Holy Spirit to help you walk this out.

And when he saw Him, immediately the spirit convulsed him, and he fell on the ground and wallowed, foaming at the mouth. 21 So He asked his father, "How long has this been happening to him?" And he said, "From childhood. 22 And often he has thrown him both into the fire and into the water to destroy him. But if You can do anything, have compassion on us and help us." 23 Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes." 24 Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears, "Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!" 25 When Jesus saw that the people came running together, He rebuked the unclean spirit, saying to it, "Deaf and dumb spirit, I command you, come out of him and

enter him no more!" 26 Then *the spirit* cried out, convulsed him greatly, and came out of him. And he became as one dead, so that many said, "He is dead." 27 But Jesus took him by the hand and lifted him up, and he arose.
