Beyond Sunday

A Sermon Application Guide It's Up To You (The Law of Faith pt 1)

This guide is designed to offer a simple tool for those wanting to take the next step with Sunday's message. You can print this guide to study on your own, or use it in a group and experience transformation together.

Our hope is that the living, breathing words of truth that are revealed to you become a part of your everyday life. In the book of James, we read about a key to living life with God. We are told that if we ask for wisdom by faith then we shall receive it generously from our Father in Heaven. One of the best ways to receive this wisdom is by preparing to receive it. We invite you to pray this prayer prior to the message and starting the study guide:

"God, thank You for Your truth and wisdom. Help me to see what I need to see, hear what I need to hear, and know what I need to know. Holy Spirit, help me to understand in a way that shows me the Father's true nature and heart. May this time help me to know You more and become more like Jesus. Amen."

Message Theme

The law of faith and the promise of its power.

Key Concepts/Truths

Faith begins where the will of God is known.

Your doubt can cancel out your faith.

The plan for our life requires faith. All of God's plans require faith.

Faith isn't passive.

Because of grace and faith, God deals with us through Jesus.

We don't have to talk God into things that He has already done.

Key Verses: 2 Peter 1:3 • Romans 3:27 • John 14:13-14 • John 16:23

Which one truth do you already have evidence of in your life today? Ask the Lord for new ways to see even more of it for you and others around you. Write your answers out.

Which one truth is the most challenging or least existing in your life today? Why do you think this is? Ask the Lord if there are any beliefs or barriers that are keeping you from believing that particular truth. Write it out.

Real-Life Application

In Mark 5, Jesus meets a woman with a health issue that she had been dealing with for twelve years. "When she heard about Jesus, she came up behind him in the crowd and touched his cloak, because she thought, "If I just touch his clothes, I will be healed." Immediately her bleeding stopped and she felt in her body that she was freed from her suffering. "Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering."

The woman acted on her faith when she believed for healing. Even though Jesus was moving through a crowd and bumping into many people, the woman was the only one who received from His power because she was the only one that touched Him with faith.

When you come to Jesus, do you come with faith or doubt? Like the woman, you can approach Jesus with faith in the authority that He won on the cross. Faith begins where the will of God is known - His Word. Trust in His will for our lives, communities, nation, and world. Have faith!

Will you be a part of bringing God's will on earth? What can you pursue this week with the law of faith?
