Our hope is that the living, breathing words of truth that are revealed to you become a part of your everyday life. In the book of James, we read about a key to living life with God. We are told that if we ask for wisdom by faith then we shall receive it generously from our Father in Heaven. One of the best ways to receive this wisdom is by preparing to receive it. We invite you to pray this prayer prior to the message and starting the study guide:

"God, thank You for Your truth and wisdom. Help me to see what I need to see, hear what I need to hear, and know what I need to know. Holy Spirit, help me to understand in a way that shows me the Father's true nature and heart. May this time help me to know You more and become more like Jesus. Amen."

Message Theme

Reversing the Devil's Decisions

Key Concepts/Truths

Our age and past failures don't disqualify us. Peter denied the Lord, David committed adultery, and Paul was literally a murderer. David was 15 when he killed Goliath. Caleb took a mountain when he was 85. Moses began his ministry at 80.

Historically, a triumph meant total and utter destruction with no way for an enemy to reassemble. We are not the devil's victim—we have authority over him in the Name of Jesus.

We've been given power and authority to trample on the devil's works to demonstrate the victory that Jesus has purchased.

God has given us the Kingdom, but we need to go in and take possession of it just as Israel needed to go into the land promised to them.

Key Verses- James 4:7 • Colossians 1:13, 2:15 • Luke 10:19

Which one truth do you already have evidence of in your life today? Ask the Lord for new ways to see even more of it for you and others around you. Write your answers out.

Which one truth is the most challenging or least existing in your life today? Why do you think this is? Ask the Lord if there are any beliefs or barriers that are keeping you from believing that particular truth. Write it out.

Real-Life Application

There is no prison wall we can't break through, no mountain we can't move, and all things are possible to us who believe in the name of Jesus.

Praise the Lord that we have his name to speak and bring things into existence for the glory of God regardless of who we are, where we've come from, or what we've done. Being salt and light in a flavorless and dark world is as simple as resisting the devil and claiming Jesus' name. As we do, our life will reflect God's love, his provision, and his kingdom. If we only believe that Jesus can do something himself, we are living a defeated life. We have been given His name to continue His work. Jesus has redeemed us to be a prosperous city on a hill, well fortified from attack. He has made us into a light in dark places.

God wants to demonstrate to the world Satan's defeat through us, and we are his warriors! When warriors train and prepare for battle, they have to know that they are facing an enemy. Warriors plan their victories by studying and using the position and strategies of their opponents. The enemy is looking to attack, and his job will only become easier if we do not recognize that we are at war with him. Stand in faith against him!

We can know the strategies and tactics of the devil through God's Word. We do not have to give him any place in our lives, but you must give him a place in your theology. If we do not recognize that the enemy seeks to devour, we will not see the attack coming. Prepare for battle by spending some time studying the tactics of the enemy.

This Week's Declarations

Life is released when your words are in agreement with God. Intentionally speaking life and biblical truth out loud is extremely powerful. In fact, you have that very life in the power of your tongue. These words below, when spoken out loud, will cause an acceleration of the reality of God's words in your life. We encourage you to speak the following with an expectancy to renew your mind and see God's fullness.

- When I take a hit, I won't quit!
- God is on my side, Jesus' blood has been applied, and every need will be supplied in Jesus' name.
- There is provision for all I need when I am walking in God's truth.
- I am not a victim, and I am not disqualified by my failures, age, or upbringing.
- Jesus triumphed over the devil, and I take possession of the reward of that victory which is the authority, power, and Kingdom life in Jesus' name.
- I will live in the authority of Jesus' name to glorify God in this world.

Greater Things

Colossians 1:13 tells us that we have been translated out of the kingdom of darkness and into the Kingdom of the Son of God. When we are loving and serving our God, we are attacking the devil and his kingdom of darkness. Seek God and be a threat to the devil and darkness. We are equipped to recognize and resist his attacks because we are children of the Most High God!

Now it's time to write down anything that the Lord has spoken to you. Praise Him, thank Him, and ask the Holy Spirit to help you walk this out.
