This guide is designed to offer a simple tool for those wanting to take the next step with Sunday's message. You can print this guide to study on your own, or use it in a group and experience transformation together. Our hope is that the living, breathing words of truth that are revealed to you become a part of your everyday life. In the book of James, we read about a key to living life with God. We are told that if we ask for wisdom by faith then we shall receive it generously from our Father in Heaven.

One of the best ways to receive this wisdom is by preparing to receive it. We invite you to pray this prayer prior to the message and starting the study guide:

“God, thank You for Your truth and wisdom. Help me to see what I need to see, hear what I need to hear, and know what I need to know. Holy Spirit, help me to understand in a way that shows me the Father's true nature and heart. May this time help me to know You more and become more like Jesus. Amen.”

Message Theme

End times

Key Concepts/Truths

- To understand what God is doing in the earth today, we must understand what God has already done
- The Kingdom of God is more about just getting us to heaven. God's will is on earth as it is in heaven.
- Replacement theology says that Israel has no special place in God's heart compared to other countries and people, which is scripturally incorrect.
- Israel is the apple of God's eye, and is God's time clock for the world.
- So many prophecies are coming true regarding Israel in this time that could have never come about until now. Desolation, destruction, and lack in the area is turning to fertility, rebuilding, and abundance just as God said.
- Scripture says that the world will be blessed by Israel. The Jewish people have a supernatural gifting to bless people through avenues of science, agriculture, medicine, and finance all because God said it would be so.
- When we stand with Israel and the Jewish people, God says that we will be blessed.
- To understand God's plan for the end times, we need to first understand Genesis.

Key Verses: Zech. 2:8 • Gal. 3:16 • Joel 3:2 • Genesis 12:1-3 • Ezekiel 35:5

Which one truth do you already have evidence of in your life today? Ask the Lord for new ways to see even more of it for you and others around you. Write your answers out.

Which one truth is the most challenging or least existing in your life today? Why do you think this is? Ask the Lord if there are any beliefs or barriers that are keeping you from believing that particular truth. Write it out.

Real-Life Application

When God says something is to our benefit if we do it, why do we put it off, hesitate, and sometimes even flat out disregard it? We know what God says about standing with his people. We know what scripture says concerning doing what God has commanded us. We also have even heard God speak things directly to us, yet we tarry; we wait and procrastinate. Why?

This is a great question to bring to Him! "Father, what is stopping me?"

If God has given us something to do, a direction to go, a main focus, let's listen and put into action what He has said. Let's be doers of His word, not just hearers as it says in James 1:22.

Make an effort today to love God and show him that you're listening. Love people, and reflect God in doing so. God has given us very specific instruction in his word, so let's dig in, listen, make his words our driving force and change the world around us for his glory.

This Week's Declarations

Life is released when your words are in agreement with God. Intentionally speaking life and biblical truth out loud is extremely powerful. In fact, you have that very life in the power of your tongue. These words below, when spoken out loud, will cause an acceleration of the reality of God's words in your life. We encourage you to speak the following with an expectancy to renew your mind and see God's fullness.

- I stand with and bless God's chosen people, Israel.
- May God's will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
- I recognize in my life what God has told me to do, and I willingly listen and obey him. • I am a hearer and a doer of God's word.
- I love God, love people, and I make it known for his glory!
