This guide is designed to offer a simple tool for those wanting to take the next step with Sunday's message. You can print this guide to study on your own, or use it in a group and experience transformation together.

Our hope is that the living, breathing words of truth that are revealed to you become a part of your everyday life. In the book of James, we read about a key to living life with God. We are told that if we ask for wisdom by faith then we shall receive it generously from our Father in Heaven. One of the best ways to receive this wisdom is by preparing to receive it. We invite you to pray this prayer prior to the message and starting the study guide:

“God, thank You for Your truth and wisdom. Help me to see what I need to see, hear what I need to hear, and know what I need to know. Holy Spirit, help me to understand in a way that shows me the Father's true nature and heart. May this time help me to know You more and become more like Jesus. Amen.”

Message Theme

Growing Your Faith

Key Concepts/Truths

Faith doesn't come by having heard once, but by continually hearing. Growth in faith requires repetition of the truth in God's word.

Bible faith is having something in your heart to the degree that it changes the way that you live.

Everything in the Kingdom of God works by faith. Faith does not move God to action, faith receives what God has already provided.

God will do everything that He said He will do. He will not change on a whim from what He says in His word.

God does not respond to us on a case by case basis by evaluating our weekly performance and behavior. We receive from God what we do not deserve because of His grace through our faith.

Jesus tells us to pray that God's Kingdom would come and that His will would be done on Earth as it is in Heaven. This wouldn't be necessary if everything that happened was God's will.

Everything in this world seen and unseen was created by words and responds to words. God gave us the same authority that He used to speak creation into existence. Likewise the words that we speak will produce life or death.

As believers in Christ, we are to demonstrate Satan's defeat by the power that works in us. God has already provided everything that we need, and we need only to flip the switch of faith to receive it.

Which one truth do you already have evidence of in your life today? Ask the Lord for new ways to see even more of it for you and others around you. Write your answers out.

Which one truth is the most challenging or least existing in your life today? Why do you think this is? Ask the Lord if there are any beliefs or barriers that are keeping you from believing that particular truth. Write it out.

Real-Life Application

Faith is not reserved for the super spiritual. If anything, our habit of over spiritualizing things limits our ability to operate in the fullness of God because we complicate and tack things on in an effort to explain concepts to our rational minds. Every person has the same access to God and to faith through Jesus' sacrifice as anyone who has ever lived. Believing anything otherwise is a lie from the devil. We know the devil is a liar and his main goal is to steal, kill, and destroy. On the flip side, Christ came to freely give life so abundantly that we wouldn't even have room for it all, causing us to naturally give it away everywhere we go.

When you catch God's perspective of faith, nothing can stop you. No matter who you are, what you have been through, or what you struggle with, God and His word are true and relevant for you. What areas of your life have you kept the relevancy of His word in a box? Where have you said "it's just not true for me", even if said subconsciously? Take time regularly to ask God and listen for His response. Our faith in God combats our doubt and propels us into all that God has for us. There is abundant life awaiting every person that has faith in God. When you speak it, when you use it, you will see His power at work in and around you.

This Week's Declarations

By faith, I receive God's abundant life promised in His word for me. His word is relevant, true, and I know that I can trust what He says. Sickness, depression, anxiety, and sin has no place in my life. Jesus has redeemed me through his death and resurrection. I am a child of God, part of His Kingdom, filled with his power and by faith I receive all His promises. Devil, you can't have me. Jesus, have all of me. Create a hunger in me to love your word. Grow my faith as I continually set myself before your word. Thank you for redeeming me, loving me, and setting me free by your truth.

What's Next?

Now it's time to write down anything that the Lord has spoken to you. Praise Him, thank Him, and ask the Holy Spirit to help you walk this out.
