Message Theme & Prayer Focus

The Kingdom Of God

"Father God, help me to see and understand the truth that you have set before me in this message, that I might believe it the way that you know it to be true and let it change me from the inside out. Holy Spirit, thank you for leading me through this transformational truth so that I can live in the Kingdom now as a child of God and citizen of Heaven, in Jesus' name. Amen!"

Key Concepts/Truths

Christianity is a Kingdom. That Kingdom is God's will being done on Earth as it is in Heaven.

Since we belong to the Kingdom there is an inheritance that belongs to us, It includes everything that is in it.

We've been taken out of the devil's kingdom of doom and gloom, depression, anxiety, disease, and brought into the Kingdom of Heaven when we believe in the new way of Jesus.

Satan talks a big game by promising people success and fulfillment. He even tried this with Jesus in the wilderness, but his words are ultimately empty, powerless, and condemning.

A kingdom operates where the word of its king is the law. When we are in the Kingdom of God and considered joint heirs with Christ, everything that is in the Kingdom is ours to live in.

God has made the church a holy and spiritual nation that is part of the same covenant that He made with the physical nation of Israel and Abraham.

The everlasting life that is promised to us by God is the same absolute life that is inside of Him.

In the Greek, this absolute life refers to the immense quality of life.

The same absolute and eternal life that is in God, was given to Jesus, who gives it to us to live in today. With it we are to experience victory, deliverance, healing, and so much more.

Key Verses:

Daily Application

An earthly kingdom operates where the word of its king is the law. The same is true spiritually. To live in the Kingdom of God is to submit everything, big and small, to God's will and Word. When God's Word is what we measure our lives with, we bring things to it and to His Holy Spirit. By doing so, we can adopt His perspective of our lives and see what it truly means to follow Him. This shifts our living out of legalism and condemnation and into who we have become as a result of spending time with Him. It becomes natural.

Living in the Kingdom of God doesn't have to be a misunderstood thing. Jesus modeled it for us.

When we are in the Kingdom of God, everything that is in it is ours to live in. Just as Jesus walked in the Kingdom, spent time with His Father, and reflected Him, we can as well. Remember, "everlasting" life speaks more of its quality and immensity than its duration. Are you walking in the everlasting life that has been given to you?

Live each day by asking the Holy Spirit to show you your life through a Kingdom gospel and eternal life perspective. Spend time with your Father God and allow yourself to be changed by Him. He is infinite and there is always more of Him available to us.

Right now, ask the Holy Spirit to show you a Kingdom perspective of your life. How does His response to you change the perspective you've had of your life so far? Rest in what He says and allow your life to look differently because of it.

This Week's Declaration

"I choose to live in the Kingdom of God today. By living in the Kingdom, I receive all that God has for me inside of it. God has already qualified me regardless of what my past or the devil has to say about me. I am a new creature in Christ Jesus, my past is gone, and I am a child of God and citizen of Heaven. The same absolute and everlasting life that is in God is inside of me. I choose today to tap into that life-giving, disease-defeating, joy-filling, strength that is the everlasting life of God. I spend time with my Father and allow Him to conform me into the likeness of His Son so that I might follow His Holy Spirit's leading and advance the Kingdom of Heaven everywhere I go in Jesus' name!"

Now it's time to write down anything that the Lord has spoken to you. Praise Him, Thank Him and ask the Holy Spirit to help you walk this out.
