Message Theme and Prayer Focus

Kingdom Inheritance

"Father God, give me eyes to see, ears to hear, and a fertile heart to receive your truth in this message. Help me to change the way I think because of it, and realign me to your Word from the inside out, further conforming me to the likeness of your Son. Give me the courage it takes to walk out the new creation that I am in you as I live in your Kingdom, in Jesus' name. Amen!"

Key Concepts/Truths

The Kingdom is now. Christianity is not about getting us into the place of Heaven. It's about doing the will of God so that we receive citizenship and can enter into His Kingdom now.

The gospel of the Kingdom is the gospel that Jesus came preaching. It is this gospel that will be preached in all the world before the end comes.

The gospel of the Kingdom is God's will being done on Earth as it is in Heaven. This includes the sick being healed, diseased people being cleansed, demons and spirits being cast out, and freely using the power and authority that we have received from Christ.

When we follow what God's Word says and engage the sick from a Kingdom perspective, we can have faith and lay hands on people. We can rest assured that God will do His part through His process of healing for them whether instantaneous or over time.

Remaining in sickness and attributing its origin to God does not glorify Him. Sickness is not called anything but a curse in the Bible. Healing from all our diseases brings glory to God.

The curse of the law is confusion, panic, destitution, disease, captivity, darkness, and destruction. Christ has redeemed us from that curse and translated us into His Kingdom where those things do not exist.

In Christ, we are spiritual descendants of Abraham. We are included in God's covenant promise. We can receive all that the Kingdom of God has available -- life, healing, restoration, deliverance, prosperity, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit.

If we simply sit back and nonchalantly say “Well, whatever God wants is going to happen”, we will never receive God’s best. This is not because God is holding back from us, but because we have an enemy in the devil who fights for our destruction. Having faith in God’s promises like Joshua and Caleb did in Numbers will have us defeating our enemy and living in everything that God has for us.

We need to be strong, persistent, and relentless to receive our full inheritance as a child of God. God’s promise is already ours, but we need to continually receive it. Much like a brand new truck sitting in our garage at home, it does us no good without actually turning the key and using it.

Daily Application

Living halfway in the Kingdom of God is like being given a brand new vehicle but keeping it in the garage without exploring even its basic functionality. We can know the car will get us from point A to point B, but without experiencing it and really feeling the wind in our hair, hearing our favorite song through the speakers, or seeing our loved ones in the seats next to us, we are missing out. There is so much genuine life and joyful experience that we’re missing out on. What a shame. We know our God is the God of exceedingly abundantly more, but so often we live content with just a small portion of His Kingdom and call it good.

Now that we’ve come to grips with the fact that there is so much more to the Kingdom of God than accepting Jesus as Savior, living a well-behaved life, and “going to Heaven”, we have a choice to make. We can continue living life halfway hoping for the best, or we can walk in God’s power, confidence, authority, and authenticity in who He created us to be. We are sons, daughters, and ruling heirs with Christ. With His grace and mercy for us that are new every morning, every single day is a chance to turn the key of that car and operate in the Kingdom fully.

Take a moment to sit and ask God if there is anything in His Kingdom that you have not been utilizing or understanding properly and allow Him to speak to you about it. Ask if there is a way that He wants you to understand that piece in a new way, to receive the life that He has for you in it. This is something you can do every day, and at any moment. Allow God to speak His truth into your life and change the way you think, behave, and live. When we do, we’ll never be the same.

This Week's Declarations

"I was bought with a price by the blood of Christ and God has delivered me from the power of darkness and translated me into His Kingdom of light and life. Christ has redeemed me from the curse of the law so that I can receive the promise of the Holy Spirit through faith being a spiritual descendant of Abraham. As I am in Christ, I receive every promise that God has sworn to those in His Kingdom: abundant life, health, deliverance, restoration, peace, joy, and so much more. I am strong and persistent in receiving the promises of God. I look for opportunities to trust and rely on Him, and I take a stand for His Kingdom, living in all the power and authority that is mine because of it, in Jesus' name!"
