# Beyond Sunday with Scripture References The Gift of Love (The Gift pt 2) A Sermon Application Guide

Our hope is that the living, breathing words of truth that are revealed to you become a part of your everyday life. In the book of James, we read about a key to living life with God. We are told that if we ask for wisdom by faith then we shall receive it generously from our Father in Heaven. One of the best ways to receive this wisdom is by preparing to receive it. We invite you to pray this prayer prior to the message and starting the study guide:

"God, thank You for Your truth and wisdom. Help me to see what I need to see, hear what I need to hear, and know what I need to know. Holy Spirit, help me to understand in a way that shows me the Father's true nature and heart. May this time help me to know You more and become more like Jesus. Amen."

## Message Theme

Agree with God and Prepare a Way

## Key Concepts/Truths

Our unbelief limits God's power in our lives, but with God nothing is ever impossible.

God's word has power. When He speaks, the power to make it come to pass is there. We can trust what He says.

The devil may have won a battle with Adam and Eve, but the power of Jesus' complete triumph over the devil won us the war.

We do not have to wait for God to defeat the devil in our circumstances because He already did!

Jesus trumps everything. He is the exact representation of God the Father and we have the invitation to be in Him.

God didn't give the law so that we could live up to it; we never could. The purpose of the law is to point us to Christ as our savior.

Living from good behavior, instead of by God's grace, will cause us to fall everytime. By faith we are justified.

The promises in God's word will be activated in our lives when we agree with what God says.

Key Verses: Luke 1:26-38 • Genesis 3:15 • Matthew 16:18 • Isaiah 7:14 • 1 Corinthians 15:45-47 • Ephesians 1:6 Luke 4:18-19 • Hebrews 1:2

Which one truth do you already have evidence of in your life today? Ask the Lord for new ways to see even more of it for you and others around you. Write your answers out.

Which one truth is the most challenging or least existing in your life today? Why do you think this is? Ask the Lord if there are any beliefs or barriers that are keeping you from believing that particular truth. Write it out.

## **Real-Life Application**

You can pick a fight with the devil. You don't have to play defense in the battle for your family, your marriage, your faith, your relationship with God, or in your areas of influence. You're not in a waiting game to see when God will defeat the devil in your life and circumstances; God already defeated him and gave you the authority to have the victory in your life. The Bible tells us in James 4:7 to resist the devil and he will flee from you. Jesus has already won back your victory!

Jesus came to win back the authority that we lost in the Garden of Eden. He was fully God and fully man meaning that He was the perfect representation of God's love and character, but He was also able to take on the sin of the world and wipe it away with His death and resurrection. Through birth, life, death, and resurrection, He reconnected you with your Heavenly Father!

All of God's promises for us are all throughout the Bible, but until we know what they are we won't be able to agree with what He says about us. Dedicate some time right now to ask God which one of His promises you need to agree with the most. Agree with what that promise and let it be done and evident in your life today.

## This Week's Declarations

Life is released when your words are in agreement with God. Intentionally speaking life and biblical truth out loud is extremely powerful. In fact, you have that very life in the power of your tongue. These words below, when spoken out loud, will cause an acceleration of the reality of God's words in your life. We encourage you to speak the following with an expectancy to renew your mind and see God's fullness.

- I know that nothing is impossible with God.
- I believe the word of God, and all of His promises for me.
- In Jesus, I am victorious over the devil.
- I have God's favor.
- Thank you God that Jesus trumps everything that counters your nature.

### What's Next?

Now it's time to write down anything that the Lord has spoken to you. Praise Him, thank Him, and ask the Holy Spirit to help you walk this out.
