Message & Prayer Focus

Equipped To Serve

"Father, thank you for creating me with purpose. I ask that you strengthen and encourage me, by your Holy Spirit, to live in that purpose for you. Open my heart to fully receive all that you have for me in this message, and to live it as a light for others to see as well, in Jesus' name. Amen."

Key Concepts/Truths

God did not just save us from something, He saved us to something–His purpose for us. He wants us to be useful in the way that He created us in His Kingdom. If we're praying for something, we need to be willing to be part of God's answer to that prayer.

Life's purpose is to love God and love others. We can't understand the purpose of life without knowing our Creator because our purpose starts with Him. Understanding our purpose without a relationship with Him is impossible.

What you are is God's gift to you, but what you do with what you are is your gift to God.

Church is an all-skate event and a full-contact sport. Life is not always sunshine and roses, but God calls us to love and serve people out of the gifts He's given us and the strength that we have in Him.

"The good life" is not just taking care of and doing everything for ourselves. The good life is when we are walking in the good works that God has planned for us, serving Him and others out of love.

A life devoted to material things is a dead life. Seeking the Kingdom of God first, over the kingdom of ourselves, will have our lives re-prioritized in a healthy and life-giving way.

If we don't have a vision of where we are heading, we will simply reflect the culture around us. We should keep our eyes on the prize. When we know our life's purpose, and live by it, we will move forward despite setbacks, confusion, and disappointment. If we aren't careful, we can get caught up in bad culture around us, allowing our love for the things of God to grow cold, ultimately making us ineffective in the Kingdom.

God has called us to be participants in what His Kingdom is doing. We will all stand before God to answer what we did with Jesus, and what we did for Jesus. We aren't saved by the works we've done, but we will be rewarded by the works we have done to build God's Kingdom.

Daily Application

Every single one of us, without exception, has received grace and been given a gift from God. It then becomes our responsibility to embrace what God has placed inside of us, take ownership of it, and do our best to use that special gift to meet the needs of one another. God, the Creator of the universe, has entrusted so much to us by placing those special gifts in our life and He is depending on us to be faithful with that responsibility.

If we're constantly waiting for our own type of "perfect conditions" to appear, in order to get started serving God and others, we will never get anything done. There is always something from health, preferences, work, or education that tries to stand in the way and keep us from doing the things that God intended for us. We need to recognize that we have already been called to do the things that God has planned for us, despite our self-image, and if He has called us to do them then He has also equipped us to do them.

In the pursuit of walking in those good works that God has planned for us, it's so important that we surround ourselves with other believers that will challenge and encourage us. God blesses the things that we put our hand to. As we get to doing those things, we will be led in the way that we should go, all while building His Kingdom. Take some time and ask God to show you the right people who can strengthen and encourage you as you serve Him. It's for all of us to love Him and love others well.

This Week's Declarations

"I love God and I love others. I actively look for opportunities to bless others, and God, by using the gifts that He created me with. I have a heart for serving others. I know that as I serve, the Kingdom of Heaven is built stronger, and that Christ will reward me when He returns. I look to encourage others around me to serve, and to strengthen those who are serving to do so even better. I choose to do life in the Kingdom with other Kingdom minded people, working to keep our eyes on the prize: Christ's return, in Jesus' name!"
