Message Theme & Prayer Focus

The Blood Of Jesus' Cross

"Jesus, thank you for your plan and your providence through your blood that was shed for me. Show me the extent of your power and love for me through the truth in this message today. Soften my heart and lead me through this truth, showing me how to grow in it and make it a regular part of my life. I love you, Lord, and I live to know you and serve you. Amen!"

Key Concepts/Truths

We shouldn't be ignorant about the things that we put our faith in. Since we put our faith in the blood of Jesus, we should know the extent of what it does for us - salvation, healing, deliverance, intercession, righteousness, access, and provision.

We were slaves, and Jesus purchased us with His perfect blood to set us free. Jesus paid for a real redemption for us with His blood that has real answers to real life problems.

The blood of Jesus does not just take care of sin, it makes us able to do every good work, to serve God, and be all that He has called and created us to be.

The Holy Spirit always points us to the cleansing and enabling blood of Jesus, reminding us of who we are in Christ. The devil will always point to our past, shortcomings, and failures, but we overcome him and his schemes by the personal testimony of the things that we have been brought through by the blood of Jesus.

The blood of Jesus is applied in Heaven, but it needs to be applied in our heart. When we apply it in our heart, it cleanses our conscience from the old ways we lived and the sins that we've committed. We'll begin to identify with who the blood makes us, rather than our past.

Because of Jesus' blood, we can come boldly before God and receive mercy for our failures and grace to enable us to continue. When we feel unqualified for any reason, the blood qualifies us beyond a shadow of a doubt.

It's through the blood that we are taken out of Satan's kingdom and put into the Kingdom of God, but it is with our words that we fight against that earthly kingdom. We never let the devil have the last word. We need our mouths to be moving and speaking the same things that the blood says.

Daily Application

We can have a lot of questions in life when it comes to our past, our present, and understanding our future. Do we identify ourselves through the blood of Jesus, or do we identify ourselves with our past successes and failures? Do we qualify for God's best blessings today even though we've done wrong things in our past? Do we even feel qualified to serve God? The blood of Jesus makes up all the difference. It makes us perfect. It enables us to serve God, and move forward in the life that He has for us.

The lies of the devil try to tell us that we're too far gone, we've sinned too great, God is mad at us, or that we're being punished because of failures. When this happens, we need to apply both our knowledge and faith in the blood of Jesus to our heart and allow it to make up the difference. When we feel condemnation, doubt, depression, or anything else that is not in God's nature begin to creep into our situation, we need to apply the blood. The things we're feeling, the things we've done, and the failures we experienced may be based on something that legitimately took place, but those things no longer define us under the blood.

The blood, when applied, delivers us and breaks the power of the things that try to oppress us. We need to be blood conscious, Word conscious, and testimony conscious. We need to be aware of what is coming out of our mouth - not in some weird legalistic manner, but to be speaking the same things that God says about us through the blood of Jesus. We are delivered, blameless, righteous, provided for, and completely redeemed. Begin to speak those things about yourself and watch it affect the way you live in victory over the devil.

This Week's Declarations

"I plead the blood of Jesus. I plead it over my family, my mind, my thoughts, my past, my future, and my conscience. I am forgiven. I am not condemned. Devil, you can't have my children, my marriage, my body, or my future. I win this case because I plead the blood. When I plead the blood I am justified. The blood of Jesus cleanses me from all sin in all of its forms and manifestations, in Jesus name!"
