Message Theme & Prayer Focus

Your Identity In The Resurrection

"Father, thank you for the truth in your word. Open my eyes to see your truth unfold in reality. Open my ears to hear your voice as I go about my day. Open my heart to receive the truth you have for me today and let it change the way I live in Jesus' name. Amen!"

Key Concepts/Truths

The fact that Jesus was raised from the dead means that in God's eyes, we are just as if we had never sinned. He restored the world to Himself through Jesus, no longer counting our sins against us.

Jesus paid a debt He did not owe because we had a debt we could not pay. Jesus was the substitute for all of us.

Adam represented us in everything that He did, but the Bible calls Jesus "the last Adam" as He has become our new representative by everything that He did.

In God's eyes it wasn't just Jesus that hung on the cross. If we are in Christ, then we also died, were buried, raised to life, and are sitting in Heavenly places. Whatever happened to Him, also happened to us.

The Gospels in scripture are like man's view of the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. The Epistles are like God's view of the resurrection because they go into greater spiritual detail and understanding of what took place in the supernatural because of what Jesus did.

Satan is the accuser that picks apart our life, sin, and past to keep us from living as God made us--justified. The strength that the devil has is in sin and condemnation, but there is no longer condemnation for those who are in Christ.

The beginning of condemnation is the end of victory, peace, and joy, but the beginning of true faith in the death and resurrection of Jesus is the end of condemnation.

You did what the devil said you did, but you aren't who the devil says you are. The price has already been paid and you are a new creation in Christ.

God promises to never leave us or even turn His heart away from us, and nothing can separate us from His love.

The resurrection is proof that we were justified. When Jesus rose, God tore the curtain in the temple that separated Himself from us.

Key Verses:

Daily Application

We know that there is no condemnation for us who are in Christ. When the devil brings up our past, it's a great opportunity to remind him of his future. Jesus has triumphed over sin, death, and the devil and we have that same victory in Him. But what does that victory look like in our daily lives? It looks like having His joy and peace when we encounter disappointment, heartache, or setback. It looks like calling on His strength when we feel like we have nothing left. It looks like, no matter what the devil tries to accuse us with, we know that Jesus' death already paid the price and has made us a new creation and brought us into His Kingdom.

Are you living life from that Kingdom perspective? You don't have to look back at the old when you have been made new, and being made new literally means that you have a new way of living. Because you've been made new, you are more than a conqueror through Jesus.

Believers are no longer under Satan's domain of sin, sickness, disease, and death. We are part of the Kingdom of God and we have everything that living in that Kingdom brings. Our sins are forgiven and our diseases are healed. We're redeemed from destruction, satisfied, renewed, and crowned with loving kindness and good things. With God as our Father we can rest in the fact that He loves us, cares for us, that we are part of His family, and in His Kingdom forever.

This Week's Declaration

I have died, been buried, and have been made alive again in Christ for the glory of God. I have been made a new creation in Christ and there is no longer any condemnation for me. I no longer live according to the old way of life and I accept everything that God has for me through Jesus' finished work on the cross. I am justified by my faith in Jesus and I know that God's heart is turned toward me. When the devil comes to accuse me of my past and the things I've done I know what God says about me. He has wiped my sin away, reconciled me, given me authority to trample on the devil, and brought me into His family. As a child of God I live to glorify my Father in all I believe, say, and do in Jesus' name!

What's Next?

Now it's time to write down anything that the Lord has spoken to you. Praise Him, Thank Him and ask the Holy Spirit to help you walk this out.
