Beyond the Sermon A Sermon Application Guide

Title: Glorifying God (Growing Deeper; a series on Romans 1:21, Part 1)

This guide is designed to offer a simple tool for those wanting to take the next step with Sunday's message. You can print this guide to study on your own, or use it in a group and experience transformation together.

Message Theme & Prayer Focus

"Going Deeper - Part 1"

"Father God, thank you for the truth in this message that you have for me. I prepare my heart to receive it, and I pray that you would encourage me and quicken my heart to honor the seed of truth that you plant in me. Thank you for continuing to speak to me, encourage me, love me, and give me the strength to carry on your plan for my life, in Jesus' name. Amen."

Key Truths & Applications

Scripture says that the deep in God calls to the deep in us, and the spirit of man is the candle of the Lord. This means that God communicates with us speaking to our heart—our spirit. He is illuminating the ways we should live and go, but it's up to us to acknowledge this by knowing Him personally, glorifying and thanking Him for who He is and what He has done.

The first step in going deeper with God is by glorifying Him.

To glorify is to consider with esteem, to value, and to prize something. God reveals Himself to us through His Word and by His Spirit so in order for us to go "Deeper in God", we must first revere and esteem His Word as He does. God has magnified His Word above His name. That means that He values and stands by His Word so highly that He will honor His Word or He would cease to be Himself. He is watching over His Word to make sure that it comes to pass.

There are some big areas of life that we can value and esteem God's Word, which in turn glorifies Him.

- 1. Gathering in community with believers. Hebrews 10:25 encourages us to continue meeting together, supporting, and encouraging one another. God designed us to live in community.
- 2. Giving of our finances to God. We're told in Malachi 3:10 to bring our tithes into the church so that plenty can be given back. Giving God the 10% He's asked for will always bless the remaining 90% to go further than the 100% ever could.
- 3. Keeping a Biblical worldview. When God's Word is our number one standard, and not cultural preferences, we'll see the world through the right lens. The health of our marriage,

children, body, work, and everything else depends on us seeing properly and acting accordingly. We can only do that when we keep God's Word the standard and not deviate because of personal feelings or convenience.

4. Serving Him with a glad heart. When we serve the Lord together, wherever we are, it blesses Him, the people that we serve, and ourselves as well. This expands His Kingdom and brings others into His family to experience His goodness.

The effectiveness of God's Word can be choked out of our lives if we value, esteem, and give weight to other things above it. We will lose our victory, peace, joy, and blessings by esteeming things above God's Word. But when we prioritize His Word as our standard, we'll see everything it says come to pass in our lives because of who God is.

The main thing is that we don't just do what the Bible says, but that we have the heart and motive to do it— that we have a heart that reveres God. We let our heart that is turned toward God be the driving force behind doing what He says cheerfully. We first adjust our heart to value God, His Word, and then allow that to adjust our actions. That's how we truly honor, esteem, and glorify God.
