

## Scripture References - Healing Belongs To You

### **Matthew 12:43-45 NKJV**

“When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he goes through dry places, seeking rest, and finds none. Then he says, ‘I will return to my house from which I came.’ And when he comes, he finds *it* empty, swept, and put in order. Then he goes and takes with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter and dwell there; and the last *state* of that man is worse than the first. So shall it also be with this wicked generation.”

### **Luke 13:10-11 NKJV**

Now He was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath. And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise herself up.

### **Luke 13:12-16 NKJV**

But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him and said to her, “Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity.” And He laid His hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God. But the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because Jesus had healed on the Sabbath; and he said to the crowd, “There are six days on which men ought to work; therefore come and be healed on them, and not on the Sabbath day.” The Lord then answered him and said, “Hypocrite! Does not each one of you on the Sabbath loose his ox or donkey from the stall, and lead it away to water it? So ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound—think of it—for eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath?”

...how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

### **Galatians 3:29 NKJV**

And if you are Christ’s, then you are Abraham’s seed, and heirs according to the promise.

### **Deuteronomy 28:45 NKJV**

“Moreover all these curses shall come upon you and pursue and overtake you, until you are destroyed, because you did not obey the voice of the Lord your God, to keep His commandments and His statutes which He commanded you.

**Job 42:10 KJV**

And the Lord turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: also the Lord gave Job twice as much as he had before.

**Luke 13:16 NKJV**

So ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound—think of it—for eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath?”

**Acts 10:38 NKJV**

...healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

**Matthew 15:21-22 NKJV**

Then Jesus went out from there and departed to the region of Tyre and Sidon. And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, “Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon-possessed.”

**Matthew 15:23-24 NKJV**

But He answered her not a word. And His disciples came and urged Him, saying, “Send her away, for she cries out after us.” But He answered and said, “I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.”

**Romans 1:16 NKJV**

...for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first...

**Matthew 15:25-26 NKJV**

Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, “Lord, help me!” But He answered and said, “It is not good to take the children’s bread and throw *it* to the little dogs.”

**Galatians 3:29 NKJV**

And if you are Christ’s, then you are Abraham’s seed, and heirs according to the promise.

**Matthew 15:25-28**

Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, “Lord, help me!” But He answered and said, “It is not good to take the children’s bread and throw *it* to the little dogs.” And she said, “Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters’ table.” Then Jesus answered and said to her, “O woman, great *is* your faith! Let it be to you as you desire.” And her daughter was healed from that very hour.

...he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!"...

**2 Corinthians 1:3 NKJV**

... the Father of mercies and God of all comfort..

**Isaiah 30:18 NKJV**

Therefore the Lord will wait, that He may be gracious to you; And therefore He will be exalted, that He may have mercy on you...

**Philippians 2:9 NKJV**

Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name...

**Psalms 145:8-9 NKJV**

The Lord is gracious and full of compassion, Slow to anger and great in mercy. The Lord is good to all, And His tender mercies are over all His works.

**Matthew 9:35**

Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

**Philippians 2:7 ESV**

...but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.

**John 14:12 NKJV**

...he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

**Acts 10:38 NKJV**

...how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

**Psalms 103:3 NKJV**

Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases...

**Matthew 8:17 NKJV**

...“He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses.”

**1 Peter 2:24 NKJV**

—by whose stripes you were healed.

**Romans 10:10 NKJV**

For with the heart one believes unto righteousness...

**Mark 6:1-2 NKJV**

Then He went out from there and came to His own country, and His disciples followed Him. And when the Sabbath had come, He began to teach in the synagogue. And many hearing Him were astonished, saying, “Where did this Man get these things? And what wisdom is this which is given to Him, that such mighty works are performed by His hands!

**Luke 4:17-18 NKJV**

And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written: “The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted,  
To proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind...

**Luke 4:21-22 NKJV**

And He began to say to them, “Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing.” So all bore witness to Him, and marveled at the gracious words which proceeded out of His mouth. And they said, “Is this not Joseph’s son?”

**Mark 6:4-5 NKJV**

But Jesus said to them, “A prophet is not without honor except in his own country, among his own relatives, and in his own house.” Now He could do no mighty work there...

**James 5:14-15 NKJV**

Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up...

**Mark 6:5 NKJV**

Now He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them.

**Mark 6:6 NKJV**

And He marveled because of their unbelief. Then He went about the villages in a circuit, teaching.

**Luke 5:17 NKJV**

Now it happened on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. And the power of the Lord was present to heal them.

**Luke 5:18-19 NKJV**

Then behold, men brought on a bed a man who was paralyzed, whom they sought to bring in and lay before Him. 19 And when they could not find how they might bring him in, because of the crowd, they went up on the housetop and let him down with his bed through the tiling into the midst before Jesus.

**Luke 5:20-26 NKJV**

When He saw their faith, He said to him, "Man, your sins are forgiven you." And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, "Who is this who speaks blasphemies? Who can forgive sins but God alone?" But when Jesus perceived their thoughts, He answered and said to them, "Why are you reasoning in your hearts? Which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Rise up and walk'? But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins"—He said to the man who was paralyzed, "I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house." Immediately he rose up before them, took up what he had been lying on, and departed to his own house, glorifying God. And they were all amazed, and they glorified God and were filled with fear, saying, "We have seen strange things today!"

**Matthew 10:7-8 NKJV**

And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.' Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.

**Mark 16:17-18 NKJV**

And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons... they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

**Matthew 10:1**

And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease.

**James 5:14-15 NKJV**

Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick...

**Acts 14:7-9 NKJV**

And they were preaching the gospel there.

And in Lystra a certain man without strength in his feet was sitting, a cripple from his mother's womb, who had never walked. This man heard Paul speaking. Paul, observing him intently and seeing that he had faith to be healed...

**Mark 5:25-28 NKJV**

Now a certain woman had a flow of blood for twelve years, and had suffered many things from many physicians. She had spent all that she had and was no better, but rather grew worse. When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment. For she said, "If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well."

**Acts 10:38 NKJV**

...how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power...

**Mark 5:30-34 NKJV**

And Jesus, immediately knowing in Himself that power had gone out of Him, turned around in the crowd and said, "Who touched My clothes?" But His disciples said to Him, "You see the multitude thronging You, and You say, 'Who touched Me?'" And He looked around to see her who had done this thing. But the woman, fearing and trembling, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before Him and told Him the whole truth. And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction."
