

Title: Heroes of Faith (Enforcing Justice pt 1)

This guide is designed to offer a simple tool for those wanting to take the next step with Sunday's message. You can print this guide to study on your own, or use it in a group and experience transformation together.

Message Theme & Prayer Focus

"Foundation of Redemption"

"Father God, thank you for another week of blessings. I know that when life is tough and my understanding runs low, that you have a plan for me. God teach me to rely on you for peace and comfort. Continue to show me that your love for me never runs out. Build my faith each day as I grow closer and closer to you. God, give me the motivation and strength to keep praying for my spouse, my family, my job, and my community. I trust you Lord, Amen."

Key Truths

The Bible tells us in Hebrews that without faith it is impossible to please God.

One third of human history is found in Genesis. We were created in God's image and to have authority and dominion over the Earth. When Adam and Eve let the devil deceive them in the garden, he stripped them from their authority. As believers we are of God, but the world around us is of the evil one.

We could ask why there are so many problems in the world, but we know that the devil is a liar, a thief, and a murderer who uses the authority that we have allowed him—the same power, authority, and dominion that God originally gave us.

The Bible is written primarily about two men, and they're both named Adam. One lived in the garden with Eve and the other is "the Lord from Heaven," as 1 Corinthians 15:45-47 describes—Jesus Christ. When the first Adam sinned, he took everybody into sin because he represented the whole human race. Just the same, when the last Adam went to the cross as our representative, He took all men into himself and paid for the sin of all mankind. That's a beautiful thing because it allows us to receive, and live in, eternal life starting now.

God so loved us that He sent his Son, Jesus, to pay the price we could never pay to redeem us from our fallen state. He made a covenant of promises with Abram to bless and prosper us, have us live in health, be protected, and so much more. Over the next couple of weeks we will

take a deeper look at the promises God gave that are ours to receive as His sons and daughters.

Practical Application

The promises from God to meet our needs, protect us, and bless us, do not mean there isn't an enemy that is ready to try to steal those promises. Things happen, we get distracted, and the busyness of life can weigh on us, but those absolutely do not negate the promises that God has for us.

- For each thing heavy on your heart, take the time to recognize that God does not cause bad things to happen. He has a provision for every single thing that you're facing. The devil comes to steal, kill, and destroy, but Jesus came that we might have life to the fullest.
- Remind yourself that God fully knows, fully cares, fully loves, and that help is on the way.
