Title: Healing Through Faith

Message Theme & Prayer Focus

All Is Well | Healed Them All, So All Is Well

PRAYER:

"God, I thank you that I am redeemed from the curse. I thank you that you paid specifically for my sins. God, you are more than enough for me. I ask you to continue to show me your grace and mercy, speaking to me, and reminding me of your provision. As I continue to learn more about you I am excited to build a deeper relationship with you. I desire to look more like your heart. Amen."

Key Truths

The Bible says we have been qualified for our share of the inheritance that God has reserved for his people. Part of that inheritance is healing.

The number one thing we need to understand about healing to receive it, is to know that it is God's will to heal us. HE desires us to be in perfect health. In the old testament, our sins were not paid for. Then Jesus came and paid for all of them, so now they are not being held against us. Once we know and understand that, we give God more space to move. It is possible to believe in something but not believe for it. We get what we believe for. We have to believe that it is God's will to heal and resist sickness and disease.

Keep in mind that when there is healing, it's a process that takes time. When there is healing from the demonic, there is immediate healing. God swore by himself that he would bless Abraham. We know that God keeps his promises and we read in the word that if we are Christ's, we are Abraham's seed. That promise is just as much for us today.

We weren't just redeemed <u>from</u> something, we were redeemed <u>to</u> something. We can limit God by not remembering what he has done for us in the past, but every testimony of what God has done belongs to us. This should cause faith in our hearts to receive what he is going to do again. Also, what God has done releases an anointing for him to do it again.

Practical Application

"The testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy"

When we hear what God has done, faith should come for him to do it again. Even more than that, when we hear what God has done, it releases an anointing to receive what he has already done.

Declarations

Declare this out loud \rightarrow "Jesus redeemed me. I am redeemed from the curse. I am redeemed from sickness and disease. I am blessed. Healing belongs to me. God's will for me is healing and health. Jesus bore my sicknesses and carried my pains. No evil

will befall me because God has given his angels charge over me to keep me in all my ways. In my pathway is life, healing and health. Jesus took my infirmities and bore my sicknesses so I don't have to. I thank you Lord. You forgive all my iniquities. I thank you that you give me authority to trample on sickness and scorpions and all power of the enemy. Satan is under my feet. I am healed in Jesus' name."

What's Next?

Now it's time to write down anything the Lord has spoken to you. Praise Him, Thank Him and ask the Holy Spirit to help you walk this out.
