Title: The Power of I Am

This guide is designed to offer a simple tool for those wanting to take the next step with Sunday's message. You can print this guide to study on your own, or use it in a group and experience transformation together.

## Message Theme & Prayer Focus

#### Power of Faith

"Father God, I am so thankful for you. I rest in this moment and recognize your goodness, your faithfulness, and your pursuit of me. I thank you for how you move and work in my life and in the people around me. Thank you for sending your son to pay for my sins and give me a new identity. I am forever grateful. Amen."

## **Key Truths & Applications**

In Matthew 26, Jesus was with his disciples in the garden of Gethsemane. He asked them for their support and prayers, before He was taken away to be crucified. This is a great example that we can follow of doing life with other people because we are not meant to go through life alone, but with others, giving and receiving support.

Many times we can think that prayer is just another checklist item without realizing that it is incredibly effective. There are different kinds of prayer–the prayer of commitment, faith, petition, thanksgiving, agreement, and intersession. Jesus prays a prayer of commitment three times before He is taken to the cross, committing His will and His body to God. Jesus is the perfect example of showing us what it means to offer ourselves as living sacrifices to God.

We need to know the will of God because we can't pray for God's will in faith if we don't know what it is. When we are tempted to do something other than His will, we should go to Jesus for strength. He knows what it's like to have our desires go one way while the will of God takes us in a different direction. When we feel like we can't go on, Jesus has the answer.

It's important to remember that when Jesus was raised from the dead, He wasn't raised alone. In Matthew 27, when the curtain in the temple's holiest place was torn from top to bottom, Jesus's death brought people back to life. This happened so we would know that God's raising of Christ from the dead was not a solo event, but that God has the power to raise us all.

What's going to happen in the end? Jesus is coming back with a shout and those who have believed in Christ and died will rise first. Then, those who are alive believing in Christ will be raised. We'll get access to Heaven and attend the marriage supper of the Lamb where the church is united with Christ. Then, we'll come back with the Lord to see His new Kingdom established on Earth, and reign with him for a thousand years.

## Declarations - (Speak this out loud)

I eagerly await the day of Christ's return and I live each day according to His will, doing all that He has called me to do in my new identity as a loved child of God."

The Power of I Am

**1 Corinthians 11:23-25 NKJV** For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me." In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."

**Matthew 26:39 NKJV** He went a little farther and fell on His face, and prayed, saying, "O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will."

**Romans 12:1 NKJV** I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.

**Matthew 26:40-44 NKJV** Then He came to the disciples and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, "What! Could you not watch with Me one hour? Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak." Again, a second time, He went away and prayed, saying, "O My Father, if this cup cannot pass away from Me unless I drink it, Your will be done." And He came and found them asleep again, for their eyes were heavy. So He left them, went away again, and prayed the third time, saying the same words.

**James 5:14-15 NKJV** Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.

**Luke 22:44 NKJV** And being in agony, He prayed more earnestly. Then His sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground.

**Hebrews 2:18 NKJV** For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted.

**John 18:3 NKJV** Then Judas, having received a detachment of troops, and officers from the chief priests and Pharisees, came there with lanterns, torches, and weapons.

**Matthew 26:47 NKJV** Judas, one of the twelve, with a great multitude with swords and clubs, came from the chief priests and elders of the people.

John 18:4-5 NKJV "Whom are you seeking?" They answered Him, "Jesus of Nazareth."

John 18:6 NKJV Now when He said to them, "I am He," they drew back and fell to the ground.

**Hebrews 9:28 NKJV** so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.

**1 Thessalonians 4:13-16 NKJV** But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus. For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. For the Lord Himself will descend

from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.

Zechariah 14:5 NKJV Thus the Lord my God will come, And all the saints with You.+

**Philippians 3:21 NKJV** who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.

**Revelation 20:4 NKJV** And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.

**Revelation 20:5-6 NKJV** But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection.
