Message Theme

The Healing Power Of God

Key Truths

If we don't water our faith, it won't grow. Reading the word, spending time with God, and stepping out in faith are ways to grow in our faith and trust.

In the Old Testament, we read that human's sins were still held against them. Then to reconcile mankind to God, there was one sacrifice that paid for all people, for all time. Now in the New Testament we don't live by the same law and our sins are forgiven through Christ.

By looking at Jesus, we can see exactly what God is like. Jesus went around doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil. God didn't send sickness. The devil introduced brokenness to the world and God sent Jesus to heal.

When Jesus went to his hometown he could not do any mighty works because of their unbelief. A lot of times we can think that God will just heal us if he wants to but that's not true. Our unbelief can get in the way of us receiving what God has for us. We can have faith and unbelief at the same time and they work against each other. If we can deal with our unbelief, it will stop working against us. If we pray for someone and don't see immediate healing, it doesn't mean it's not God's will for them to be healed. Healing can be in an instant but most of the time it is a process.

Practical Application

Some things to keep in mind this week:

- 1. There is more to salvation than being forgiven and going to heaven. Part of being saved is receiving healing.
- 2. We are sons and daughters of Abraham and are heirs according to the promise. Healing was purchased for us. All of us.

Mark 9:24-27 NKJV "Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!" When Jesus saw that the people came running together, He rebuked the unclean spirit, saying to it, "Deaf and dumb spirit, I command you, come out of him and enter him no more!" Then the spirit cried out, convulsed him greatly, and came out of him. And he became as one dead, so that many said, "He is dead." But Jesus took him by the hand and lifted him up, and he arose.

James 5:14-15 NKJV ... anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up.
