Title: Unmasking (Forces of Darkness pt 1)

Prayer

"Thank you Jesus for coming in a flesh and blood body to defeat the devil once and for all. Thank you for the fact that I get to walk forward with the authority to stand up to the enemy. God you have always been faithful to me and you always will be."

Message Theme

Jesus The Deliverer

Key Truths

We have to be proactive and resist the devil. When we resist him, we are also resisting his works and attempts to sabotage our life. Part of belonging to the kingdom of God is having authority to confront and resist the devil. God's desire is that the victory Jesus has over the enemy be made known. We can do this by demonstrating the devil's defeat, walking out the truth of the gospel. Jesus would preach and teach, he would heal, and he would confront and cast out devils. Now we can do these things and more. The world around us is under the power of the evil one. But if we believe in God's name, signs and wonders will follow us.

Signs of demonic activity:

- 1. Withdrawal from social interaction
 - a. We were created for social interaction.
 - b. The devil will try to isolate us from our community.
 - c. Just because God blesses us doesn't mean that he approves of all we do. God wants us to have Godly friends.
- 2. A tormented mental state
 - a. The devil can't touch God but he can touch what God loves, which is us.
 - b. When an evil spirit is manifesting it can never admit Jesus came in the flesh.

Practical Application

The devil <u>can not</u> make us do anything. The authority that Jesus has, he left with the church.

Submit to God, resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

- <u>Submitting to God</u> looks like following His example, desiring His will for your life, and trusting Him in each and every area of your life.
- Resisting the devil requires taking every thought captive. Do not let the devil speak lies to you. Fill your mind with words of truth and life. The enemy wants access to you but standing up to him is letting him know he may not have you, your family, your health, or your job.

Also he begged Him earnestly that He would not send them out of the country. Now a large herd of swine was feeding there near the mountains. So all the demons begged Him, saying, "Send us to the swine, that we may enter them." And at once Jesus gave them permission. Then the unclean spirits went out and entered the swine (there were about two thousand); and the herd ran violently down the steep place into the sea, and drowned in the sea. So those who fed the swine fled, and they told it in the city and in the country. And they went out to see what it was that had happened.

And when He got into the boat, he who had been demon-possessed begged Him that he might be with Him. However, Jesus did not permit him, but said to him, "Go home to your friends, and tell them what great things the Lord has done for you, and how He has had compassion on you." And he departed and began to proclaim in Decapolis all that Jesus had done for him; and all marveled.

"Be angry, and do not sin": do not let the sun go down on your wrath, nor give place to the devil.
