Title: Kingdom Living Hacks - A Healing Message

Message Theme

Your Healing Now

Prayer Focus

"Thank you, Father God, that you are always true, loving, and faithful. I thank you that as your child I have every inheritance that you've promised me, and that includes healing in my body, my heart, and my mind. Thank you that you've made me whole, righteous, and have brought me back into relationship with you. I receive what you have for me through this message, and I will walk in it by the strength of your Spirit. Amen."

Key Truths

Jesus is our absolute healer! When we're faced with sickness and disease it can be discouraging, but to know that Jesus has already bore all of that on the cross for us. We don't have to stay bound to what isn't ours!

There's nothing wrong with taking medicine for an issue—doctors are good—but we should go to God first, and doctors second. He is our source of healing, so take your medicine in Jesus' name!

Most Christians today would pray to God to get Him to do something on their behalf—like grant healing—without realizing that it has already been given freely as an inheritance of being a child of God. Paul prays in Ephesians that our eyes may be opened and enlightened to see the riches of the power of God's might which is already at work with us. Jesus has made us His ambassadors and given us His name, which means we bear His name and authority to act on His behalf unto His glory.

Jesus said the Kingdom of God is here, now, and within us. He is the one that qualifies us for it and translates us into it. Now that we're a member of that Kingdom of light and no longer in the kingdom of darkness, the issues and inheritances of that kingdom of darkness are no longer ours whatsoever.

We don't have to settle for things that don't belong in or around us, we have authority over them. The victorious Christian is one who knows what they've inherited from God by way of faith, who walks in it, and who uses their authority and their mouth to speak God's truth into reality over the enemy's lies.

God hasn't made us sick, and the devil doesn't make us well. God's not mad at us and punishing us with sickness and disease. He's not testing us with those things, nor does He hold our sins against us. Jesus is perfect theology, and He heals! If we've believed lies like this in the past, the only thing we need to do is allow God to change the way we think and come into agreement with God's truth. It's for us to resist the devil by standing firm in the faith—what we know to be true—and carry on in that truth.

Practical Application

We can be far more aligned with God's Word and His will for us simply by stopping what we're doing out of our own strength, resting in Him, and allowing Him to show us Himself inside of us. His glory is there, His power is there, His nature is there. When we come into agreement with that, we can do more as the royal sons and daughters of God with a single decree than we could ever do as a soldier marching to the beat of our own drum. He has called us sons and daughters, given us an inheritance to use, so let's do exactly that and live the abundant life He desires for us.

Which one truth from above do you already have evidence of in your life today? Which one truth is the most challenging or least existing in your life today? Ask the Lord if there are any beliefs or barriers that are keeping you from believing that particular truth, and spend some time talking with Him about any that show up. Ask the Lord for new ways to see even more of His truth in your life—to catch His revelation—for you and others around you.

Declarations
