# **Key Truths**

#### Why did Jesus have to go to the cross and die?

The Book of Genesis is essential to understanding why Christ died on the cross. From the very first page of the Bible, we witness the creation of the world and mankind. Humans were created in God's image and given dominion over the earth. Adam and Eve, the first man and woman, were placed in the Garden of Eden and instructed not to eat from a particular plant, the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil. But Satan, disguised as a serpent, went to Eve and manipulated her into doubting God's command, making her believe that God was withholding something from them. When Eve ate the forbidden fruit and gave it to Adam, they fractured their relationship with the Creator. The world fell into Satan's domain. As our representatives in the garden, Adam and Eve acted on behalf of all humanity. Therefore, we're all born as sinful people.

After many generations, God promised Abraham that He would bless all his descendants. He made a covenant with Abraham, which was a binding agreement that both parties must uphold. God promised that another Adam would represent us, allowing us to avoid the punishment for original sin. Since all people were affected by Adam and Eve's sin, God would have to pay for all of Abraham's debts. In return, God asked Abraham to sacrifice his only son, Isaac. Abraham was willing to do so. However, God did not require Isaac's blood and blessed Abraham for his obedience. In the New Testament, we see the fulfillment of the covenant between God the Father and God the Son.

God's promise became flesh when Mary gave birth to Jesus. Christ came to represent us and undo what Satan did in the Garden of Eden by repairing our relationship with God.

## **Practical Application**

Jesus didn't just go to the cross for everybody else; He went for *you*. Imagine it this way: they say that people's lives flash before their eyes when they pass away. On the cross, as Jesus suffered in shame and agony, instead of His own life flashing before His eyes, your life did. He thought of *you* as He paid the price for sin.

Consider these questions:

- What part of this story resonates with you the most today?
- Did you find any part of it new or presented differently?
- Is there anyone you know who needs to hear this story? Consider sharing this good news with them.
