Title: The Priest of God - Scarlet Line Part 4

Message Theme

Through the blood of Jesus, believers receive forgiveness, redemption, access to God, victory over the enemy, and the ability to serve as priests in God's kingdom.

Prayer Focus

Key Truths

- The blood of Jesus is essential for salvation. There is no other way to be forgiven or enter God's presence.
- The blood of Jesus brings victory. It overcomes the accusations of the enemy and gives us power to live righteously.
- We are made priests by the blood. Every believer, not just clergy, is called and empowered for service.
- The blood cleanses us to serve God. Forgiveness allows us to serve God with a pure conscience.
- God has a unique plan for each believer. We find our fulfillment by walking in the path God prepared.
- True greatness comes from serving. Following Jesus's example means putting the needs of others before our own.

Practical Application

The sacrifice of Jesus offers incredible promises. But how can we experience them in our daily lives? Let's explore some practical ways to connect with that power every day.

1. **Reject Accusations:** When guilt or condemnation try to creep in, remember your legal standing. Plead the blood of Jesus as your defense.
2. **Speak the Blood Out Loud:** Boldly declare, "I plead the blood of Jesus over my mind, my family, my health, my finances..." The blood breaks the enemy's power. Pastor will do a confession with you at the end of the message, stay tuned, or click on the Confession Chapter marker now.
3. **Know Your Inheritance:** Because of Jesus, you're a priest! You have authority, and you represent God. Walk with the confidence His sacrifice and your calling have given you.
4. **Embrace Your Anointing:** The blood of Jesus makes you a priest. Whatever your daily life looks like, bring God's kingdom there. Serve others as an act of worship.

The blood of Jesus purchased your freedom, forgiveness, and restoration. Don't let any area of your life remain under bondage.

The Priest of God

1 Peter 1:18-19 NKJV knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

Colossians 1:13 ESV He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son,

Colossians 1:13 TLB For he has rescued us out of the darkness and gloom of Satan's kingdom and brought us into the Kingdom of his dear Son,

Acts 20:28 NKJV ...the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

Romans 3:25 KJV Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

Revelation 1:5-6 NKJV and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. Exodus 7:16 NKJV ...“Let My people go, that they may serve Me in the wilderness”;...

1 Peter 2:9 NKJV But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

Deuteronomy 10:8 NKJV At that time the Lord separated the tribe of Levi to bear the ark of the covenant of the Lord, to stand before the Lord to minister to Him and to bless in His name, to this day.

Hebrews 7:12 NKJV For the priesthood being changed, of necessity there is also a change of the law.

Amos 9:11 NKJV “On that day I will raise up The tabernacle of David, which has fallen down, And repair its damages; I will raise up its ruins, And rebuild it as in the days of old;

Mark 16:15 NKJV And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.

Colossians 1:20 NKJV and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross.

Colossians 2:14 NKJV having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.

Hebrews 10:19 NKJV Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus,

Hebrews 4:16 AMPC Let us then fearlessly and confidently and boldly draw near to the throne of grace (the throne of God's unmerited favor to us sinners), that we may receive mercy [for our failures] and find grace to help in good time for every need [appropriate help and well-timed help, coming just when we need it].

Hebrews 12:24 NKJV to Jesus the Mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than that of Abel.

Ephesians 4:11-12 NKJV And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ,

Ephesians 2:10 AMP For we are His workmanship [His own master work, a work of art], created in Christ Jesus [reborn from above—spiritually transformed, renewed, ready to be used] for good works, which God prepared [for us] beforehand [taking paths which He set], so that we would walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us].

Romans 14:17 NKJV for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

Luke 17:21 NKJV ...the kingdom of God is within you.”
