Power Of The Promise

Prayer Focus

Thank you for the gift of salvation and the new life you created in me. I'm so grateful for your love and forgiveness. Help me to surrender my own desires, and open my heart to receive your power and guidance. Let me embody your love, joy, and strength in my everyday life. Grant me the boldness to be a light in the world and use me to bless others. Thank you for the promise of the Holy Spirit. I trust in you, Lord. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Key Truths

The Kingdom of God is getting the word in you.

The baptism of the Holy Spirit is really about us having the power to demonstrate and enforce the Kingdom of God.

God promised Abraham that through him all of his descendants would be blessed, yet Abraham was old and still had no children. God made a covenant with him to show His promise. We read in the Bible, "If you are in Christ, then are you Abraham's seed and heirs according to the promise." We receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

When John the Baptist looks at what is going to happen in Jesus' ministry, he says the number one thing that is going to bring the Kingdom is baptizing with Holy Spirit and fire. The Spirit puts us into the body of Christ, the Church baptizes in water, but Jesus baptizes us in the Holy Spirit. What the Spirit does gets us into heaven, water baptism brings deliverance from the world. Being baptized in the Spirit by Jesus gives us the power to demonstrate the kingdom of God.

Practical Application

Have you received the Holy Spirit since you believed?

When we accept the Lord as our savior we get the Spirit in us but there is a difference between getting a drink of water and going swimming. Jesus wants to immerse us in the Spirit.

The baptism in the Holy Spirit is different from receiving salvation and being water baptized; it empowers believers for Kingdom living. Here are some practical steps to help you live out your faith boldly and authentically.

- 1. **Know the Holy Spirit is for EVERYONE:** Let go of trying to "reach" a certain spiritual level, God promised the Holy Spirit for all His children. Jesus fulfilled that promise, starting with the disciples. This isn't just for special Christians it's for you.
- 2. **It's All About Power:** The baptism in the Holy Spirit isn't just a feeling, it's about being equipped to demonstrate God's kingdom power right here and now. The Holy Spirit will empower you! Be open to opportunities to share your faith, pray for others, and step out of your comfort zone.
- 3. **It's Received by Faith**: We can't earn this gift. Just as we receive Jesus through faith, we receive the fullness of the Holy Spirit the same way.
- 4. **Ask God:** If you haven't received the baptism of the Holy Spirit ask God for it, Desire it and Expect it! Repeat this simple prayer after me:

Dear God, You say in Your Word that the Holy Spirit is a good gift and that everyone who asks for the Holy Spirit receives it. I ask to be baptized in the Holy Spirit in Jesus' Name. I thank you for filling me, for empowering my life to be a witness for You, and for giving me the gift of tongues. Now, just like Paul, I will pray with my understanding, and I will pray with the spirit. I believe I receive right now! In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Embrace the power of the Holy Spirit and become the unshakeable, impactful believer God created you to be.
