Title: God's Transformative Favor

This guide is designed to offer a simple tool for those wanting to take the next step with Sunday's message. You can print this guide to study on your own, or use it in a group and experience transformation together.

Message Theme

We can know, receive, and partner with God's favor in our lives.

Key Truths

Favor is defined as: 'the friendly disposition from which kindly acts proceed. To assist, provide special advantages, and receive preferential treatment.'

God's favor is freely given, not because of what you have done, but in spite of what you have done.

God's favor can get you anywhere in 24 hours. God's favor can open doors for you that would never happen without Him.

One day of favor can do more than a thousand years of labor.

A renewed mind toward favor knows that the Father has qualified you to share in the inheritance of His holy people in the kingdom of light. (Col. 1:12)

Key Verses:

Luke 2:7-14 • Psalm 5:12 • Romans 8:32 • Psalm 103:2-5

Which one truth do you already have evidence of in your life today? Ask the Lord for new ways to see even more of it for you and others around you. Write your answers out.

Which one truth is the most challenging or least existing in your life today? Why do you think this is? Ask the Lord if there are any beliefs or barriers that are keeping you from believing that particular truth. Write it out.

Practical Application

Excerpt from *"Unleashing the Force of Favor"* by Duane Vander Klok

For years now, I have not left my house a single day without first praying for favor. Prayer is the best place to start when you want to grow in favor. I ask God for an abundance of His favor every day. God has an abundance to give, and each morning is a great time to ask for it.

According to Ruth 2:16, Ruth found favor with Boaz, and he directed his men to let handfuls of grain fall on purpose for her to glean. I confess "handfuls on purpose" for my family. I thank God for surrounding us with favor as with a shield (see Psalm 5:12) and for crowning each of us with glory and favor ("glory and honor" in Psalm 8:5 can be translated "glory and favor"). I pray for each family member by name: "Lord, surround Jeanie with favor as with a shield. Lord, crown Stephanie with glory and favor...."

Later in the day, I might find myself on a tight schedule. Needing to make a quick - at least I hope quick - stop at the store, I start feeling rushed. As I think about how much longer I will be standing in the checkout line, a cashier approaches and says, "I'm just opening up my aisle. Please step over; I can help you." I step to the front, knowing God's favor is at work. Favor is free for the asking, as Jesus announced one Sabbath day when He read aloud in the synagogue of Nazareth, His hometown:

And there was handed to Him [the roll of] the book of the prophet Isaiah. He opened (unrolled) the book and found the place where it was written. The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon Me, to preach the good news (the Gospel) to the poor; He has sent Me to announce release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to send forth as delivered those who are oppressed [who are downtrodden, bruised, crushed, and broken down by calamity], To proclaim the accepted and acceptable year of the Lord [the day when salvation and the free favors of God profusely abound]. Luke 4:17-19 AMP

How would your days look this week with this same approach?

Declarations

Life is released when your words are in agreement with God. Intentionally speaking life and biblical truth out loud is extremely powerful. In fact, you have that very life in the power of your tongue. These words below, when spoken out loud, will cause an acceleration of the reality of God's words in your life. We encourage you to speak the following with an expectancy to renew your mind and see God's fullness.

- *God, thank you that I am in Jesus and He is in me. Father, thank you that I can increase just as Jesus increased in wisdom, stature, and favor with you and with people.*
- *I walk in God's favor every day.
I am a child of God.*

- *I believe that God's favor abounds in my life.
When the favor of God rests on me, blessings chase after me.*

What's Next?

Now it's time to write down anything that the Lord has spoken to you. Praise Him, Thank Him and ask the Holy Spirit to help you walk this out.
