Title: Healing by Grace

Message Theme

God Wants You Whole

Prayer Focus

Dear God, through Christ's sacrifice, I receive healing and freedom. Thank You for granting me authority over the enemy and teaching me to walk in Your power. You are Jehovah Rapha, the Lord who heals. Continue to guide me in meditating on Your Word and receiving Your healing. In Jesus' name, amen.

Key Truths

We must water the seeds of God's Word. Hearing it once is not enough; we must meditate on it continually. By reading the Bible and learning from its pages, we gain a deeper understanding of God's character and promises.

We're saved by grace through faith, and trying to earn our salvation makes us fall short. The Old Testament, often called the ministry of condemnation, highlights our need for salvation and how we can earn it. The New Testament teaches that faith relies on knowledge—we cannot trust God for what we don't know. The more we learn about God and His character, the more our faith strengthens. Knowing God's will is essential for true surrender. We can confidently believe in our healing and freedom once we understand that Jesus paid for every sickness and disease on the cross. It's God's will to heal, but the Devil tries to convince us otherwise. We must reassure our hearts that Jesus' sacrifice is sufficient. We can limit His work if we doubt God's desire to heal.

Practical Application

The laying on of hands is a fundamental aspect of Christianity, and we should actively practice it. God calls us to surrender to His will and partner with Him to bring His Kingdom to Earth.

When we've endured a challenge for a long time, we may become accustomed to it and doubt God's desire to heal us. Today, we must reaffirm what Jesus accomplished through His death, burial, and resurrection. The enemy seeks to steal God's blessings from us, but we must stand firm against him. The Devil is under our feet, and we have the authority to remind him of that truth.

These practical steps will help equip you to experience God's healing in your life and bring understanding to the role of faith in resisting the enemy's attacks.

First - Understand the Process: Recognize that receiving healing can be a process, not just a miraculous one-time event. Combat the accusations of the enemy by assuring your heart that what Jesus did on the cross is enough. Don't let doubt or condemnation hinder your faith in God's promises for healing.

Second - Receive Healing by Grace Through Faith: Understand that healing is received by grace, which is what God freely gives us, not because we deserve it, but because of His love and mercy. Faith is not about earning but about trusting in God's promises. Release the idea of trying to earn healing through your actions.

Third - Expect Recovery: Recognize sickness as a work of the enemy and resist it through the authority you have in Christ. Refuse to accept sickness as God's will for your life and actively resist it through prayer and declaration of God's Word. Trust in God's promise that as you pray and believe, healing will manifest, leading to gradual recovery and restoration.
