Message Theme

The Reality of the Afterlife - focuses on the eternal nature of human existence, the importance of being spiritually prepared for life after death, and the finality of one's state at the point of death.

Key Concepts/Truths

Life Beyond Death: Our current life is temporary and that there is an eternal kingdom that awaits us after death. As believers, we are to see ourselves as pilgrims just passing through this world. Have an eternal perspective and focus on the things of God rather than getting entangled in worldly affairs. While earthly things may rise and fall, God's Kingdom is everlasting and constantly increasing.

Human Nature and the Trichotomy of Man: We are made up of three parts: spirit, soul, and body. Our spirit is the true essence of who we are, and it's connected to God's spiritual realm. While our body may die, our spirit lives on eternally.
