Message Theme

The Kingdom of God...and Politics

Prayer Focus

Lord, from the very beginning, Your design for mankind was perfect. Thank You for revealing Your heart through Scripture and providing all we need to live in Your Kingdom. When the world presses in, and confusion surrounds us, we turn to You for strength and guidance. Help us stand firm in Your truth and live according to Your design. In Jesus' name, amen.

Key Truths

Jesus is active in the world, continuing His ministry in the present. Throughout history, the Church has remained countercultural, choosing to live in a way that sets it apart. One can look to the many examples of Christians who've chosen faith over worldly conformity, even when it cost them their lives—such as those who refused to worship emperors. Christians have historically stood against practices such as abortion, promiscuity, and the idolatry of kings and leaders.

Many Christians abstain from voting, believing that God's will shall prevail regardless of their participation. However, we can't be passive and expect to see God's will unfold. He has a plan and a purpose for every nation, and as believers, we have our part to play. We're called to be salt and light, living as an example to the world; we must stand apart and embrace a mindset focused on God's Kingdom for everything.

The enemy roams this earth, seeking whom he may devour, delighting in division and confusion, particularly in identity matters. As Christians, we hold firmly to the truth that God created two genders and instituted marriage as a union between one man and one woman. The Father established these principles at the beginning of creation. Rather than allowing culture to influence our faith, we must let our faith shape how we engage with the world.

Practical Application

As you dive into God's Word, you'll renew your mind and develop a Kingdom perspective. His design for you is intentional and perfect. Before you were born, He formed you in your mother's womb, and His plan for your life is flawless. When the world becomes loud and confusing, anchor yourself in God's promises. Continually return to Scripture to discover your identity and purpose. Remember, standing *with* God often means standing *against* the world.
