#### **Trust God's Promises for Your Future**

#### **Desire and Develop Spiritual Gifts**

Read 1 Corinthians 12:27-31 and identify the spiritual gifts you feel drawn to. Pray for wisdom and guidance to cultivate those gifts. Practice using them within your church or community to serve and uplift others.

#### **Walk in Faith and Grace, Not Striving**

Embrace God's grace by releasing the pressure of performance and letting the Spirit flow naturally through your life. In moments of stress or challenge, pause to pray, surrender your efforts, and allow God's grace to work through you.
