# **Prayer Focus**

# Key Truths

Believing in Jesus' name means much more than just acknowledging Him; it involves experiencing and knowing Him deeply through our daily lives and prayers. Many Christians pray to Jesus, recognizing that He came to restore our relationship with God. Christ taught us to pray to the Father in His name, which gives us access to His incredible power and authority. When we invoke the name of Jesus in our prayers, it's as though He's right there with us, providing strength and guidance.

When Jesus gave us His name, he also gave us the full authority accompanying it. By saving us from our sins, Jesus enabled God to show mercy upon us, bridging the gap between humanity and the divine. If we wish to understand God's nature, we look to Jesus, the perfect representation of God the Father. Jesus' rest after the crucifixion wasn't due to fatigue but because He completed His work. The authority Jesus demonstrated in the spiritual realm is the same authority we possess in the physical. We can confront the enemy. Jesus wants to be revealed through the church to combat the forces of darkness.

This deeper understanding of Jesus' role and the authority we have through Him empowers us to live confidently and boldly. God called us to use this authority to resist the enemy and bring light, love, and hope into the world. Just as Jesus conquered death and the grave, we're called to live victoriously, exercising the power and authority Christ gave us. Let us walk in faith, knowing that in Jesus' name, we can overcome any obstacle and fulfill the mission He has entrusted to us.

#### **Practical Application**

Are you living below your rights and privileges as an heir? Salvation comes with benefits similar to an

all-access pass. It's not just about forgiveness and entry to heaven; we also receive the name of Jesus Christ to use against the enemy. Instead of asking God to remove the Devil, we can stand up to the enemy through His Son's name. We don't need to ask God to do it for us. Is there something you are standing up for? Find someone to stand with in all the power and authority that is in yours in Christ.
