Title: The Secret to Miracles (The Name of Jesus pt 1)

This guide offers a simple tool for those wanting to take the next step with Sunday's message. You can print this guide to study on your own or use it in a group and experience transformation together.

Message Theme

Faithfully Owning Our Authority In Christ

Prayer Focus

God, I thank you for your mighty name and power. You are so good and are above all else. Thank you for loving me and showing me what it means to be loved. Strengthen me to live in Christ and experience your truth and reality in my life. Amen.

Key Truths

There is a difference between believing in Jesus and believing in the *name* of Jesus. Having confidence in the name of Jesus means we believe if hands are laid on us in the name of Jesus we will be healed—not simply needing Jesus to miraculously show up in the room and do the healing Himself. It's believing that the name of Jesus is exactly the same as Jesus being in the room with us.

All of Jesus' power and authority is in His name and as believers, we have been given access to all of it because we have access to all of Him. The power that someone's name holds is determined by the resources associated with it. Jesus physically walks this earth through us, as ambassadors, and gives us His power and all the resources that come along with it. So often we can pray for God to come and take care of the enemy for us, but God has given us the authority to resist steadfastly.

A representation of the name of Jesus is in the story of Moses. Moses' staff had the power of Jesus and as he raised it, the Red Sea obeyed and was split. Just like in that example, when we call on the name of Jesus, His power is there and we are accessing it. This power isn't for making things happen according to our own will through manipulation, but to accomplish the will of our Father God. Our prayers don't get answered because of what we have done but because of how good God is.

Practical Application

We must be proactive and continue to use the name of Jesus to set things just as they ought to be and as a weapon against the enemy, and it's all available to us simply because God loves us. He loves us with the exact same love He has for Jesus. We're included in Him. We understand that Jesus died *for* us, but in reality, God sees it as that Jesus died *as* us. Our sin has been paid for in full and there is purpose and identity for us to walk in. Here are some helpful practicals to keep your mind fixed on Christ, living in His reality, and bringing Heaven on Earth.

1- Speak the Word of God daily and keep it in your heart.

2 - Meditate on His Word. Look not only at what God was saying when it was written but also what it means for us today and what He continues to say through it.

3 - Do what His Word says. How can you participate in what the Bible says? What is God asking of you?

What's Next?

This week we learned from Pastor Duane how the early church relied on the authority of Jesus' name to perform miracles and spread the gospel. The principles below will help you understand and apply that same power in your own life, allowing you to walk in victory and bring God's kingdom into everyday situations.

Believe in the Authority of Jesus' Name

Reflect on the truth that the name of Jesus carries the same power and authority as His physical presence. Strengthen your faith by reading Acts 3 and other scriptures that showcase miracles done in His name. Affirm daily that you have access to this same authority for overcoming challenges in your life.

Use the Name of Jesus in Prayer and Spiritual Warfare

When you face difficulties or spiritual battles, actively declare the name of Jesus over your situation. Pray

confidently, knowing that His name has power over sickness, fear, and any obstacle. James 4:7 reminds us to resist the devil, and he will flee—use the name of Jesus to do so.

Live with Kingdom Purpose and Boldness

Just as the apostles preached the kingdom and used the name of Jesus for miracles, embrace your role in advancing God's kingdom. In your daily interactions, offer prayer in Jesus' name, share your faith boldly, and rely on the authority of His name to demonstrate God's love and power in the world.
