Title: Justified by Faith

This guide offers a simple tool for those wanting to take the next step with Sunday's message. You can print this guide to study on your own or use it in a group and experience transformation together.

Message Theme

How Faith in the Blood Brings Peace and Righteousness

Prayer Focus

Lord Jesus, remind me that You're my advocate before God when I stumble. When the enemy tries to deceive me, help me stand firm in Your promises. I plead the blood of Jesus over my life and declare the victory You've won for me. Strengthen my heart and assure me of my identity in You. In Your name, I pray, amen.

Key Truths

Apart from Christianity, every religion is humanity's attempt to reach out to God. However, in Christianity, it began with God reaching out to us. The value of blood connects to the value of life, so the blood of goats and bulls was never enough to pay for our sins. Only Jesus' blood is sufficient to cover everyone's sin. There are two reasons why Christ's blood achieved what no other could: God paid for our redemption with His own life, and Jesus' life was perfect and sinless. He's the only one capable of redeeming us.

No one can reach Heaven through good works alone. We've all sinned and need a Savior. As Jesus hung on the cross, God placed our guilt on Him and, in turn, gave us Jesus' righteousness. Everyone will live somewhere forever. We can either choose to spend eternity with God or eternal separation from Him. When God looks at us, He doesn't see our sin; He sees us carrying His Son's righteousness and our debt paid in full. The Devil can convince us of many things but can't counterfeit God's peace. Unless we're made aware of God's promises and blessings, we will live a substandard Christian life. We limit God if we don't know what His blood purchased for us.

Practical Application

The enemy will try to convince us that we've messed up too much or are too broken. He feeds us lies and deception in an attempt to distance us from God. Our encouragement is in 1 John 2:1-2: "But if anybody does sin, we have an advocate with the Father—Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world."

When the enemy tries to deceive us, we need to plead the blood and speak the promises of God. Assure your heart and remind the enemy of who you are in Christ.

What's Next?

Understanding the power of Jesus' blood is essential for living a victorious Christian life. His sacrifice not only cleanses us from sin but also secures our identity, assures our hearts, and empowers us to walk in peace and righteousness. By applying these principles daily, we can confidently stand against the enemy's accusations, renew our minds with God's truth, and live in the fullness of Christ's victory.

1. Understand and Declare Your Identity in Christ (Pleading the Blood)

To walk in victory, you must first grasp that your salvation and righteousness come solely from the blood of Jesus, not your own efforts. When facing doubt, guilt, or temptation, verbally declare the power of His sacrifice by saying, "I plead the blood of Jesus over my life." Regularly remind yourself of scriptures that affirm your identity, such as *2 Corinthians 5:21* ("I am the righteousness of God in Christ"). By doing this, you silence the enemy's accusations and build confidence in Christ's finished work.

2. Assure Your Heart Through Daily Confession (Speaking God's Promises)

Speaking God's promises strengthens your faith and aligns your heart with His truth. Create a list of scriptures about healing, provision, and victory, and confess them daily. For example, declare Philippians 4:19 ("My God will supply all my needs") and Isaiah 53:5 ("By His stripes, I am healed"). You can also incorporate daily

communion as a tangible reminder of Jesus' sacrifice. Through consistent confession, your mind is renewed, and your faith is strengthened, enabling you to stand firm in God's promises.

3. Live in the Peace and Righteousness of Christ (Walking in Victory)

True peace comes from knowing that you are right with God through Jesus. When challenges arise, trust in His provision and protection, knowing you are covered by His blood. Let His righteousness shape your daily actions, allowing His character to shine through you. When you fall short, quickly repent and return to step one, resting in His grace. Living this way fosters a lifestyle of faith, gratitude, and obedience, demonstrating to the world the power of Christ's redemption.

By understanding, confessing, and walking in the power of Jesus' blood, you can experience lasting peace, confidence, and victory in your life. No matter what comes your way, remember that you are redeemed, righteous, and secure in Christ. Keep declaring His promises, standing on His truth, and living in the freedom He has given you!
