Title: The Law of Faith and Healing

This guide offers a simple tool for those wanting to take the next step with Sunday's message. You can print it to study on your own or use it in a group to experience transformation together.

### Message Theme

Divine Healing: Jesus Gave You the Authority

### Prayer Focus

*Father, I thank You for the inheritance You gave me through Jesus. I declare Your Word is truth; His sacrifice makes me healed, empowered, and victorious. I will not shrink back in fear but stand firm in faith, resisting the enemy. Sickness and darkness have no hold on me because I walk in the authority of Christ. Fill my heart with trust, and let my life reflect the power of Your Kingdom. In Jesus' name, amen.*

### Key Truths

Jesus is the representation of God. If we want to understand the Father's heart and desires, look at the life and example of His Son.

During His time on Earth, Jesus did three significant things: preached the gospel, healed the sick, and delivered people from demonic power. During His time here, Jesus operated not as God but as a man, fully human. And yet, He tells us that we'll do *even greater* works than He accomplished. Since He moved in authority as a human being, we, too, can walk in the same power.

Our faith grows through hearing and receiving the Word of God. Because of Jesus' sacrifice, we're qualified to share in the same inheritance He possesses. A vital part of this gift is God's unwavering desire to heal *all* sickness and iniquity.

Sickness isn't always the result of a direct demonic attack, but it entered the world through the influence of the enemy. Scripture affirms that it's biblical to pray for the sick. When Jesus ministered to the suffering, He often *declared* healing rather than simply asking God for it, demonstrating faith in action.

Faith begins in the heart. If we struggle to believe that God will fulfill His promises, it becomes difficult to experience them. When we trust Him, we don't prepare for the worst; we live in expectation of His goodness. As the seed of Abraham, we're heirs to healing and every spiritual blessing.

Though the world remains under the power of the Devil, bringing chaos and destruction, Jesus has already completed His work against Satan until the time of His return. Until then, God calls us to resist the enemy, flee

from his schemes, and walk in the authority given to us. He's entrusted us with the power to trample over every work of darkness and stand victorious.

## **Practical Application**

Today, we must actively stand against the enemy's attacks. 1 Peter 5:8-9 warns us: *"Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith..."*

The power of God is already at work within us, but it must be active; we cannot afford to be passive, simply hoping the enemy will back down. Scripture is clear: when we actively resist Satan, he will flee.

## **Declarations**

So when the enemy comes at you with lies and deception, declare the truth out loud:

- *God has not given me a spirit of fear but of power, love, and a sound mind.*
- *I have the authority to trample the enemy underfoot.*
- *Satan and God are not equals; God has already won.*

Let every declaration remind you that God has secured victory through Christ.

## **Cultivate Your Faith in God's Healing Word**

Your faith for healing grows by consistently hearing and meditating on God's Word. Make it a daily habit to study scriptures related to healing, such as Psalm 103, 1 Peter 2:24, or Acts 10:38. Focus on passages that reveal Jesus as the healer and the Father's good will towards your health. Understand that healing is a **benefit** of your relationship with God, an **inheritance** you've been qualified for through Jesus. Let this truth sink deep into your heart, combating any thoughts that God might desire sickness for you.

### **Actively Declare and Receive Healing**

Once your heart is saturated with God's Word, move into active declaration and reception. Identify specific promises of healing that apply to your situation and **confess them out loud**. Just like the woman with the issue of blood, keep speaking what God has said about your healing. Believe that these promises are true for you, and true for you *now*. Remember, God has already provided for your healing; your faith is the means by which you **receive** it. If you need physical healing, command sickness to leave your body in Jesus's name, knowing you have authority.

### **Resist Sickness and Walk in Authority**

Recognize that sickness and disease are works of the enemy, not from God. **Actively resist** any symptoms or negative thoughts that contradict God's promise of healing. This isn't passive acceptance; it's a **violent** taking of what God has already given you, as seen in the examples of the centurion and the woman with the issue of blood. Understand that the **power of God is at work in you**, and your part is to use the **authority** Jesus has given you. Don't wait for a feeling; act in faith, knowing that God's spiritual laws of healing are always in effect.

By consistently applying these three steps, you can cultivate a dynamic faith that accesses the divine healing God has provided.
